Re: **Notice of Potential Liability and Request for Information** Pursuant to Section 104 of CERCLA at Operable Unit Two of the Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Superfund Site which includes the J.M. Mills Landfill in Cumberland, Rhode Island.

Dear Mr. Funke:

This letter serves to formally notify Three R Transportation, Inc. of the potential liability which it has or may have incurred with respect to Operable Unit Two of the Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Superfund Site which includes the J.M. Mills Landfill, in Cumberland, Rhode Island ("Site"). In addition, this letter requests that you pay certain costs related to the Site and that you prepare to participate in the conduct or financing of certain clean-up activities at the Site. This letter seeks your cooperation in providing information and documents relating to the environmental conditions at, and cleanup of, the Site.

NOTICE OF POTENTIAL LIABILITY

The United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") has documented the release or threatened release of hazardous substances, pollutants or contaminants at the Site.

Under Sections 106(a) and 107(a) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(a) and 9607(a) ("CERCLA"), and other laws, responsible parties may be obligated to undertake actions deemed necessary by EPA to protect the public health, welfare or environment. Responsible parties may also be liable for all costs incurred by the government in responding to any release or threatened release at the Site. Such costs may include, but are not limited to, expenditures for investigation, planning, clean-up response and enforcement activities. In addition, responsible parties may be required to pay damages for injury to, destruction of, or loss of natural resources, including the costs to assess such damages.

Responsible parties under CERCLA include persons who are current or former owners and/or operators of a site, persons who arranged for disposal of hazardous substances at a site, or persons who accepted hazardous substances for transport to a site selected by such persons.

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EPA has evaluated a large body of evidence in connection with its investigation of the Site, including Site business records, manifests, state records, and corporate records. Based on this evidence, EPA has information indicating that you are a potentially responsible party ("PRP") with respect to this Site. Specifically, EPA has reason to believe that you accepted hazardous substances for transport to disposal or treatment facilities and selected this Site for disposal.

By this letter, EPA notifies you of your potential liability with regard to this matter. EPA also encourages you, as a PRP, to reimburse EPA for the costs incurred to date as set out below. At the present time, CCL Custom Manufacturing, Inc. ("CCL") is under an obligation to perform all of the work for the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study ("RI/FS") and Bestfoods is under an obligation to finance the RI/FS at the Peterson/Puritan Site through a July 13, 2001 Second Amendment to the Administrative Order on Consent ("Second Amendment"). EPA encourages you to voluntarily enter into discussions with CCL and Bestfoods and to cooperate and participate with CCL and Bestfoods in the performance of the RI/FS at the Site.

DEMAND FOR PAYMENT OF COSTS

In accordance with CERCLA and other authorities, EPA has undertaken certain actions and incurred costs in response to conditions at the Site. These response actions are described below. The costs to date associated with these actions are approximately **\$762,131.45**, excluding interest. EPA anticipates that it will expend additional funds for response activities at the Site under the authority of CERCLA and other laws, including those response activities described below.

In accordance with Section 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a), a demand is hereby made for payment of the above amount, and all interest authorized to be recovered under that Section or under any other provisions of law. Demand is also hereby made under these authorities for payment of all future costs, and interest thereon, that EPA may accrue in regard to the Site.

In the event the addressee of this notice intends or has already filed for dissolution or reorganization under bankruptcy laws, you are hereby requested to include EPA-Region I, and the United States Department of Justice on any mailing or notice lists used in that proceeding. The United States reserves the right to file a proof of claim or application for reimbursement of administrative expenses in such a proceeding.

Contained in Enclosure F of this letter is a current summary of the costs expended for this Operable Unit of the Site. As you may be aware, PRPs are entitled to review the invoices which form the basis for EPA's past costs. Some of these documents may contain information that EPA's contractors claim is entitled to confidential treatment. The Agency's past practices has been to obtain the consent of the contractors pursuant to 40 C.F.R. 2.209(f) (confidential business information regulations) before releasing this information to PRPs. These regulations, however, have been revised to allow information on past costs to be released provided that the interested party sign a Confidential Business Information Agreement ("Agreement") not to disclose this information.

This Agreement is necessary to protect the interests of the submitters in the confidentiality of the business information. No party is under any obligation to execute this Agreement. Without executing this Agreement, however, the Agency cannot release documentation on past costs. If you are interested in reviewing these documents, please contact the Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Superfund Information Line ("Information Line") at 617-918-1177. The Information Line was developed by EPA to ensure that both your general and specific questions would be handled in a timely and consistent manner. Please leave a detailed message and we will make every effort to return your call within two business days.

INFORMATION REQUEST

EPA is continuing with its investigation into the release or threatened release of hazardous substances, pollutants, and contaminants at the Site. This investigation includes an inquiry into the identification, nature, source, and quantity of materials transported to or generated, treated, stored, or disposed of at the Site. EPA is also seeking information concerning those persons responsible for the cleanup of the Site and their ability to undertake or finance that cleanup.

Pursuant to the authority of Section 104(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9604(e), you are hereby requested to respond to the Information Request set forth in Enclosure A to this letter.

While EPA seeks your voluntary cooperation in this investigation, compliance with the Information Request is required by law. Failure to provide a complete truthful response to this Information Request within **thirty (30)** days of your receipt of this letter, or to adequately justify such failure to respond, may subject you to an enforcement action by EPA pursuant to Section 104(e) of CERCLA. This provision permits EPA to seek the imposition of penalties of up to twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500) for each day of non-compliance.

Please note that responses which are incomplete, ambiguous, or evasive will be treated as complete non-compliance with this Information Request. Also be further advised that provision of false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representations may subject you to criminal penalties under 18 U.S.C. § 1001.

This Information Request is not subject to the approval requirements of the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, 44 U.S.C. § 3501 et seq.

RESPONSE ACTIVITIES AT THE SITE

EPA has already conducted the following activities at the Site:

1. A time-critical removal action in response to tanks, still bottoms and drums located at the Site and to restrict access to the Site in the construction of a fence; and
2. A time-critical removal action in response to asbestos disposal and fence repair.

EPA is planning to conduct the following activities at the Site:

1. Remedial Investigations to identify the local characteristics of the Site and to define the nature and extent of soil, air, surface water and ground water contamination at the Site;
2. Feasibility Studies to evaluate the feasibility of possible remedial actions to remove or contain hazardous substances, pollutants and contaminants at the Site;
3. Design and implementation of a Remedial Action for the Site to be approved by EPA; and
4. Operation, maintenance and monitoring of the Site as deemed necessary by EPA.

In addition to those enumerated above, EPA may, pursuant to its authorities under CERCLA and other laws, decide that other response activities are necessary to protect public health, welfare or the environment.

SPECIAL NOTICE AND NEGOTIATION MORATORIUM

At an appropriate point in the future, you will receive an additional notice informing you that one or more of the above activities is pending and that your cooperation is being requested to negotiate the terms of an agreement to perform or finance these activities.

This forthcoming notice will serve to inform you that EPA is using either CERCLA Section 122(e) Special Notice procedures to formally negotiate the terms of a consent order or consent decree to conduct or finance site response activities at the site or it will inform you that EPA is not using such procedures pursuant to Section 122(a). If EPA does not use Section 122(e) Special Notice procedures, the Section 122(a) notice will explain why the Special Notice procedures were not appropriate in this case. Under Section 122(e), EPA has the discretionary authority to invoke Special Notice procedures if EPA determines that such procedures would facilitate an agreement between EPA and the PRPs and would expedite remedial action at the site. Use of the Special Notice procedure triggers a moratorium on certain EPA activities at the site. The purpose of the moratorium is to provide a period of time when PRPs and EPA may enter into formal negotiations allowing PRPs the opportunity to conduct or finance the response activities at the Site.

PRP Steering Committee:

EPA recommends that all PRPs meet to form a PRP steering committee which will function as a group representing and pursuing the interests of the PRPs. Establishing a manageable group is a critical component of the negotiation process. To facilitate negotiations at an appropriate time in the future, EPA will conduct a meeting with responsible parties. At the meeting, EPA will detail the existing knowledge about conditions at the Site and describe the past response activities that have been taken at the Site to date. Since there may be a large number of PRPs, EPA may request that the individual persons or company representatives who attend the meeting appoint a committee to represent them in negotiations.

Administrative Record

In accordance with Section 113(k) of CERCLA, EPA must establish an administrative record containing the documents used by EPA to select the appropriate response action for the Site. An administrative record for Operable Unit 1 of the Site has been previously established. An administrative record for Operable Unit 2 of the Site will also be established. TIMING AND FORM OF RESPONSE TO THIS LETTER

In addition to your continued obligations with respect to the ongoing Information Request, you as a potentially responsible party, should notify EPA in writing within **twenty-one (21) days** from receipt of this letter regarding your willingness to perform or finance the response activities described above. If EPA does not receive a timely response, EPA will assume that your company does not wish to negotiate a resolution of its liabilities in connection with the Site and that your company has declined any involvement in performing the response activities.

Your letter should indicate the appropriate name, address, and telephone number for further contact with you. If you are already involved in discussions with state or local authorities, engaged in voluntary clean-up action, or involved in a lawsuit regarding this Site, you should continue such activities as you see fit. This letter is not intended to advise you or direct you to restrict or discontinue any such activities; however, you are advised to report the status of those discussions or actions in your response to this letter and to provide a copy of your response to any other parties involved in those discussions or actions.

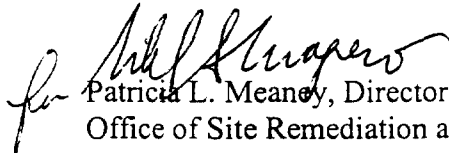

- This request imposes a continuing obligation upon you to submit responsive information discovered after your original response is submitted to EPA.

INFORMATION REQUEST QUESTIONS

1. Information or Knowledge of Waste Delivered to the J.M. Mills Landfill:

NOTE: In response to the August 24, 2000 Information Request you indicated that the CEO of The Three R's Transportation, Inc. ("Three R's"), Mr. Calvin C. Overlock, said the company never hauled rubbish until 1981 and never made any deliveries to the J.M. Mills Landfill (also referred to as "Mills") in Cumberland, RI. Please see the attached documentation, Attachments 1 through 10, which specifically show that Three R's hauled waste to the J.M. Mills Landfill between October 1978 and January 1979. Please indicate in your response to the individual questions below whether this evidence refreshes Mr. Overlock's recollection of these or additional deliveries to the J.M. Mills Landfill.

NOTE: All questions in this section refer to the period being investigated unless otherwise indicated.

a. For the following questions, please refer to Attachment #1, which contains Three R's transaction number #33 dated October 19, 1978 and the corresponding bills of lading receipts identified as Control No. 2361 and 2362. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Load of Batteries to Mills";
- ii. size of the load;
- iii. type(s) of battery;
- iv. physical condition of batteries (e.g. solid or semi-solid, leaking);
- v. type of container(s) used to transport batteries;
- vi. condition of transport containers (e.g. sealed or punctured, closed or open);
- vii. type of vehicle used to transport;
- viii. method of removal from transportation vehicle; and
- ix. amount of time each load was possessed by Three R's.

b. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 2361 in Attachment #1. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "30 Yd. Batteries for Disposal";
- ii. explanation of "yd." quantity and/or volume;
- iii. "compactor"; and
- iv. "+50 O/T of Batteries".

c. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 2362 in Attachment #1. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Exchange 50YD O/T";

- ii. "opentop";
- iii. capacity and/or volume of "opentop"; and
- iv. difference(s) (if any) between "opentop" and "compactor".

d. For the following questions, please refer to Attachment #2, which contains Three R's transaction number #44 dated October 26, 1978. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Load of Sludge to Mills";
- ii. size of the load;
- iii. physical and chemical composition/characteristics of the sludge;
- iv. type of vehicle used to transport the sludge;
- v. type and condition of containers used to transport the sludge; and
- vi. removal process of sludge from the transportation vehicle.

e. For the following questions, please refer to Attachment #3, which contains Three R's transaction number #64 dated November 17, 1978. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Mills Slip";
- ii. "Load of Drums to Mills";
- iii. volume of drums;
- iv. material and condition of drums;
- v. content of drums and content's characteristics; and
- vi. removal process of drums from transportation vehicle.

f. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 2668 in Attachment #3. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Load off Sludge";
- ii. process of load off; and
- iii. resting place of sludge at the site after unloading (e.g., proximity to the river, railroad tracks, or boundaries of the landfill).

g. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 2545 in Attachment #4. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Bulk Sludge in Roll-Off";
- ii. characteristics of "bulk sludge";
- iii. differences between "bulk sludge" and "sludge"; and
- iv. details of the "roll-off" process.

h. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 2570 in Attachment #4. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Sawdust Sludge";

- ii. reason for the correction;
- iii. whether sawdust was used for absorption; and
- iv. if used for absorption, the type and nature of substance that was absorbed.

Please define and explain the following:

Please define and explain the following:

- ii "Fly Ash";
- ii composition and particle size of "Fly Ash";
- ii the discrepancies between Control No. 3117 which states "Fly Ash" and the corresponding Three R's transaction #137 which states "Load of Sludge to Mills"; and
- ii whether Three R's performed a "pick-up at Boston Edison Mystic Station" and delivered the waste directly to the J.M. Mills Landfill.

m. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 3108 in Attachment #7.
Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Box sludge";
- ii. composition and characteristics of box sludge; and

- iii. difference(s) between "box sludge", "bulk lime sludge with iron" (Control No. 2763), "lime sludge" (Control No. 2763), "organic sludge" (Control No. 2721), and "sludge" (Control No. 2668).

n. For the following questions, please refer to Attachment #8, which contains Three R's transaction number #147 dated December 28, 1978 and the corresponding bill of lading receipts identified as Control No. 3241, 3243, 3109, and 3254. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Load of Rueping East to Mills";
- ii. composition and characteristics of the load;
- iii. size, weight, and state (e.g., solid, liquid, or gas) of the load; and
- iv. who, what, or where is "Rueping East".

o. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 3241 in Attachment #8. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Crushed empty scrap drums";
- ii. difference between "scrap drums" and "drums"; and
- iii. condition and type of drums (e.g., left open or sealed, punctured or intact).

p. The following questions specifically refer to Control No. 3243 in Attachment #8. Please define and explain the following:

- i. "Leather trimmings";
- ii. composition and characteristics of the leather trimmings; and
- iii. quantity of leather trimmings.

q. Please describe in general the material, volume, and particular use of transportation containers, as well as the types of waste found in these containers used by Three R's to bring waste to the J.M. Mills Landfill including, but not limited to:

- i. drums;
- ii. cartons;
- iii. pails;
- iv. tanker trucks;
- v. packer trucks;
- vi. roll-off trucks; and
- vii. pickup trucks.

r. Please describe:

- i. how waste (including but not limited to sludge, bulk sludge, organic sludge, lime sludge, bulk lime sludge with iron, box sludge, fly ash, and leather trimmings) was transported;

- ii. whether transportation containers remained at the site (e.g., containers were emptied at the landfill or containers were unloaded at the landfill without being emptied); and
 - iii. where waste was unloaded at the J.M. Mills Landfill.
- s. Please describe the relationship between Three R's and Recycling Industries ("Recycling") as demonstrated in Attachment #9, including:
- i. the daily operations;
 - ii. the hauling arrangements (e.g., was Three R's hired by Recycling to transport waste to Recycling and also from Recycling to the J.M. Mills Landfill. Include a description of the frequency, volume and kinds of waste);
 - iii. the accounts and/or billing arrangements.
- t. In answering the questions above, please also consider Attachment #10, which contains additional evidence that Three R's hauled waste to the J.M. Mills Landfill.

2. Information About Others:

- a. If you have information concerning the operation of the Site or the source, content or quantity of materials placed/disposed at the Site that is not included in the information you have already provided, provide all such information.

INFORMATION REQUEST INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Answer Every Question Completely.** You are required to provide a separate answer to each and every question and subpart of a question set forth in this Information Request. Incomplete, evasive, or ambiguous answers shall constitute failure to respond to this Information Request and may subject you to the penalties set out in the cover letter.
2. **Number Each Answer.** Number each answer with the number of the question to which it corresponds.
3. **Provide Information about the Period Being Investigated.** You are required to answer each question with respect to the period being investigated, unless the question specifically states otherwise. If the response fails to address the period being investigated, EPA will consider this a failure to comply with the request and may take action against you for this noncompliance.
4. **Provide the Best Information Available.** You must provide responses to the best of Respondent's ability, even if the information sought was never put down in writing or if the written documents are no longer available. You should seek out responsive information from current and former employees/agents. Submission of cursory responses when other responsive information is available to the Respondent will be considered non-compliance with this Information Request.
5. **Identify Sources of Answer.** For each question, identify (see Definitions) all the persons and documents that you relied on in producing your answer.
6. **Submit Documents with Labels Keyed to Question.** For each document produced in response to this Information Request, indicate on the document (or in some other reasonable manner) the number of the question to which it responds.
7. **Continuing Obligation to Provide/Correct Information.** If additional information or documents responsive to this Request become known or available to you after you respond to this Request, EPA hereby requests pursuant to CERCLA Section 104(e) that you supplement your response to EPA. Failure to supplement your response within 30 days of discovering such responsive information may subject you to \$27,500 per day penalties. Enclosure B

SITE DESCRIPTION

The Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Superfund Site consists of two Operable Units encompassing over two miles of mixed industrial/residential property in the towns of Cumberland and Lincoln, Rhode Island. The Site is situated in the north-central portion of Rhode Island along the Blackstone River and includes a portion of the Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor.

Operable Unit 2 of the Site, sometimes referred to as the J.M. Mills Landfill, is located predominately in the town of Cumberland. Operable Unit 2 is surrounded by industrial, residential and semi-rural properties. Bordering the Site to the north is the Hope Webbing Company property located at 88 Martin Street. To the south is the Stop and Shop Market (and strip mall) on Mendon Road (Route 122). To the east is the Mackland Sand and Gravel operations and wetlands formerly known locally as "New River". Finally, to the west is the Blackstone River.

EPA has reason to believe that Operable Unit 2 of the Site was used for disposal of wastes, including wastes containing hazardous substances, from approximately 1954 to 1986. Within this period of time, the property was primarily used as a privately-owned, mixed municipal and industrial landfill. Sewer sludge was also disposed as part of the daily operation. Various types of large, bulky solid materials (including, but not limited to, tanks, crushed drums, pre-formed concrete structures, railroad ties, demolition debris) are deposited aside of the landfill, along the north and south access roads and along the bank of the Blackstone River. The Site includes an area to the south of the landfill which was a former transfer station. Materials were stored along the Providence and Worcester rail road tracks to the east bank of the Blackstone River. To the west, and including the Pratt Dam, there is an access point to a small unnamed island within the river. The Site also includes two access roads, current and former, from Martin Street to the north and Route 122 (Mendon Road) to the south. The now closed Lennox Street municipal well in Cumberland is located approximately 1000 feet South-east from the flank of the landfill. This well was closed by the Rhode Island Department of Health in 1979 due to the presence of volatile organic contaminants found in the supply water.

Preliminary samples taken from the Site indicate the presence of volatile organic contaminants (including, but not limited to, trichloroethylene, freon 11, 1,2-dichloroethene, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, benzene) and chromium, nickel, lead, in groundwater. Contaminants found in soils and sediments include benzo(a)pyrene, chrysene, indeno(1,2,3-cd)pyrene, bis(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate, aroclors, and asbestos insulation/transite.

EPA included the Peterson/Puritan, Inc. Site (which includes the J.M. Mills landfill) on the Superfund National Priorities List on September 8, 1983. EPA conducted two separate removal actions on the landfill (September 25, 1991 and September 12, 1997, respectfully) to prevent and maintain controls of unauthorized access to the property and protect against exposures to identified harmful contaminants until further assessments are made. EPA plans to conduct a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study to assess the need for additional environmental response(s) at the Site.

Compliance Incentives

Commenting on Federal Enforcement Actions and Compliance Activities

The Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act (SBREFA) established an ombudsman ("SBREFA Ombudsman") and 10 Regional Fairness Boards to receive comments from small businesses about federal agency enforcement actions. The SBREFA Ombudsman will annually rate each agency's responsiveness to small businesses. If you believe that you fall within the Small Business Administration's definition of a small business (based on your Standard Industrial Code (SIC) designation, number of employees or annual receipts, defined at 13 C.F.R. 121.201; in most cases, this means a business with 500 or fewer employees), and wish to comment on federal enforcement and compliance activities, call the SBREFA Ombudsman's toll-free number at 1-888-REG-FAIR (1-888-734-3247).

Your Duty to Comply

If you receive compliance assistance or submit comments to the SBREFA Ombudsman or Regional Fairness Boards, you still have the duty to comply with the law, including providing timely responses to EPA information requests, administrative or civil complaints, other enforcement actions or communications. The assistance information and comment processes do not give you any new rights or defenses in any enforcement action. These processes also do not affect EPA's obligation to protect public health or the environment under any of the environmental statutes it enforces, including the right to take emergency remedial or emergency response actions when appropriate. Those decisions will be based on the facts in each situation. The SBREFA Ombudsman and Fairness Boards do not participate in resolving EPA's enforcement actions. Also, remember that to preserve your rights, you need to comply with all rules governing the enforcement process.

EPA is disseminating this information to you without making a determination that your business or organization is a small business as defined by Section 222 of the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act (SBREFA) or related provisions.

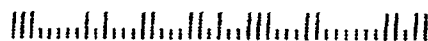
