INTRODUCTION

This document is the Index to the Administrative Record File for the Atlas Tack Corporation Superfund Site Removal Action. The Index cites site-specific documents and guidance documents used by U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) staff in selecting a response action at the site. The Potentially Responsible Party (PRP) conducted removal activities in 1992 in response to the First Unilateral Administrative Order (UAO) issued to them by EPA. Since the PRP has failed to comply with the Second UAO issued by EPA, this will be the first EPA fund-lead removal action at the site. The following actions will be undertaken by EPA and their contractors: 1) evaluating the structural integrity of all buildings for the health and safety of on-site workers prior to removal of asbestos-containing material (ACM); and 2) removing friable ACM from the east building, the west building, and the power plant. The On-Scene Coordinator (OSC) will continue investigative activities on the Site as cleanup proceeds and as materials are removed, and will address additional time-critical hazards at this site as they are discovered.
