Dear Mr. Marschner:

This letter will confirm our telephone conversation of October 9, in which, after speaking with Tom Walsh of Carroll Reed, I authorized your Office to go forward with the installation of a six-foot chain link fence to secure the pile of allegedly hazardous waste material that is present in part on property owned by Carroll Reed. I understand that it should take about one week to build the fence, and that its cost of \$6,000 will be borne entirely by the State of New Hampshire.

I would appreciate it if you would speak with your contractor and make sure that he understands that a business is being conducted at the site by Carroll Reed, and that he should make every effort to install the fence with a minimum of disruption and inconvenience to Carroll Reed's customers and employees. Carroll Reed endorses your Office's decision to secure the subject area with a fence so that public health and safety might be protected.
