Re: Certification of Procurement Process

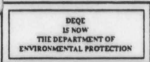
Dear Mr. Burrell:

The purpose of this letter is to request that the Environmental Protection Agency certify the Department's procurement of Emergency Oil Spill Cleanup and Containment (EOSCC) and Hazardous Materials Emergency Response (HMER) contractors. Please note that this procurement was nearly identical to the Department's last EOSCC procurement which was certified by your agency on January 13, 1989.

Effective August 1, 1989 the Department entered into agreements with nine firms utilizing the Commonwealth's open order encumbrance mechanism. Those firms are:

Attached for your review is the Standard Proposal and Agreement package for this procurement which includes the Proposal and Agreement and the Record of Decision detailing the evaluation process.



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
