

This Proposed Plan presents EPA's change to the current cleanup remedy for Operable Unit 1 (OU1) at the Savage Municipal Water Supply Superfund Site

In 1991, EPA issued a Record of Decision (ROD) initiating re-medial action for the cleanup of contamination in groundwater at the Site. In 1996, an Explanation of Significant Differences (ESD) was issued which augmented the cleanup approach in OU1. While the cleanup remedies have greatly reduced the amount of con-taminated groundwater since their implementation, contamination still remains within the overburden and bedrock aquifers at the Site. Therefore, EPA is proposing to amend the 1991 ROD and the groundwater remedy currently being implemented at OU1 to
