Dear Mr. Stockton:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") respectfully requests permission for EPA, its agents, contractors, and other authorized representatives to have access to property owned by the Boy Scouts of America, Green Mountain Council located on Boy Scout Camp Road, Eden Mills, Vermont.

EPA requests access to the property to conduct a preliminary assessment/site investigation ("PA/SI") as part of activities associated with the Vermont Asbestos Group Mine Site ("Site"). A PA/SI is necessary to evaluate the potential danger to public health and/or the environment posed by the release or threat of release of hazardous substances. The type of activities which EPA expects to perform include sampling of air, dust, and soil.

EPA also requests access to documentation which provides information about materials, including hazardous substances, pollutants or contaminants, or hazardous waste, that were generated, treated, stored, or disposed of at the Site. In addition, if you have information and documentation regarding other parties involved in the activities which may have resulted in contamination at the Site, you should contact Sharon C. Fennelly, EPA Enforcement Coordinator, at (617) 918-1263.

EPA is allowed to seek this information and conduct such investigations pursuant to Section 104(e) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), as amended 42 U.S.C. § 9604(e). The authorization provided by CERCLA includes access to private property for the purpose of determining the need for response actions, performing response actions, and/or enforcing CERCLA.

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Please signify your consent to access by signing the enclosed access agreement and returning it to me at the above address. The access agreement must be signed by an authorized representative of the owner of the property. Please provide the name, address, and telephone number of a designated contact for future communications. Please reply to this request within five (5) business days of your receipt of this letter. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet responding to frequently asked questions about EPA's authority to access property under CERCLA.

Your cooperation in assisting with completion of activities at the Site is appreciated. If you have any questions, I may be contacted at (617) 918-1274.
