Introduction to the Collection

This is the administrative record for the Olin Chemical Superfund Site, Operable Unit (OU) 1, Wilmington, MA, Administrative Settlement Agreement for Payment of Response Costs by Prospective Purchaser, EPA Region 1 CERCLA Docket No. 01-2024-0015 (Prospective Purchaser Agreement or PPA), signed in August 2024. The file contains site-specific documents and a list of guidance documents used by EPA staff that form the basis for the decision.

This administrative file replaces the proposed Administrative Settlement Agreement for Payment of Response Costs by Prospective Purchaser, EPA Region 1 CERCLA Docket No. 01-2024-0015 (Prospective Purchaser Agreement or PPA) for public comment, released in July 2024.
