SUMMARY REPORT FOR THE WEEK OF JANUARY 11, 1987

January 14, 1987

Mr. Steve Hambos and Mr. Arron Levy of Fred C. Hart, Inc. conducted the metal detection survey at the Great Swamp site using a Fisher M Scope, Pipe/Cable Locator, Model Number TW-5. The survey was observed by Ms. Tammy Mittower of Ebasco Services Incorporated. The Survey began, after calibration of the metal detector, at the southwest corner of the site and continued east along Line "A". Each fifty foot grid line area (running perpendicular to Line "A") was surveyed north to south and thirteen positive readings were obtained. One drum was observed in the Great Brook south of the site. Foam materials were observed along the southern boundary of the site.

January 15, 1987

The same personnel were at the site. Fourteen positive readings were obtained. The survey was conducted along lines "B" and "C" (which run from east to west) and the grid lines running north to south.

January 16, 1987

The same personnel were at the site. The metal detection survey was completed at the northwest section of the site. Eighteen positive readings were recorded.
