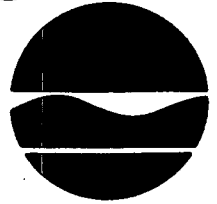

On February 14, 1986 I met with Mr. John Eckert of Eckert Energy Savers in connection with his claim that Natural Energy Increase, Inc. could install a Starbard Weather/Water Station, designed to purify the land, air, and water for a radius of 26 miles in connection with remediating the St. Regis Reservation, General Motors, Alcoa and Reynolds sites at Massena, New York.

Mr. Eckert told me (see Enclosure #1) "that the Starbard Weather/Water Station is marketed on a 10-year maintenance lease, with money-back performance guarantee. The 2,124 sq. mi coverage would detoxify St. Regis land on both sides of the St. Lawrence River plus the populated areas of St. Lawrence and Franklin counties. Using 100,000 pop., the cost is about 23¢/acre/yr. or \$5/resident/yr."

The following information is contained in Enclosure #2, on Page 2, under "Nature of the Business":

"Natural Energy Increase, Inc. is a California based corporation which manufactures and markets Starbard Natural Law Stations and other polarity devices. These products are based on polarity technology. Both the stations and the polarity devices utilize a combination of land and sea elements that together generate natural energy far greater than the sum of the individual components. The Starbard Natural Law Stations attract positive radiation which has the ability to alter the physical and chemical components of solids, liquids and gases.

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"Simply stated, polarization restores natural balance to atoms which have formed a negative energy orientation. Through polarization, negative energy attractions are reversed and natural, positive balances are restored. Polarization, therefore, can eliminate poisons, neutralize harmful radiation, make toxic chemicals inert, and purify water."

Pages 3 and 4 of Enclosure #2 describe the product and its process. The Process description (on Page 4 of Enclosure #2) states, in part, as follows: "When an object or target radiating negative energy is placed near a Station, the positive energy from the elements polarizes the object and diffuses the negative energy. Pollution, poisons, and major wind and water disturbances are all believed to radiate negative energy and are thus treatable with polarization."


At the bottom of Page 4 and the top of Page 5 of Enclosure #2 under "Market" the following is stated: "The Starbard Natural Law Stations and Polarity Pillows are useful to any consumer who could benefit from a pollution-free environment. Polarity cleanses consumables, air, water, and soil."

"Farmers wanting purified soil for better production, military operations desiring a cleansing of toxic wastes, (Underlining is added for emphasis) utility companies attempting to control radiation of nuclear waste and those simply seeking a purified environment can all benefit from the product."

On Page 5 of Enclosure #2, the following statements are made: "Local establishments have been targeted for the initial marketing program and extensive communications have been exchanged with Aerojet General Corporation, the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, McClellan Air Force Base, Mather Air Force Base, the State of California and the City of Sacramento. President Reagan and key committee persons in the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives have also been kept informed of the communications involving Federal Establishments, as well as the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in Washington, D.C., in Cincinnati, Ohio, and San Francisco, California." (Underlining is added for emphasis.)

I would appreciate the United States Environmental Protection Agency's evaluation of the Starbard/Weather Water Station for the treatment of contaminated soils and wastes at Superfund sites. I await your response.

Lying downwind from the aluminum industrial complex of three major firms; GM, Alcoa and Reynolds at Massena, NY, the St. Regis Mohawk Reservation is recognized as one of the most polluted areas in the state. This industry has unwittingly poisoned the very land it was to prosper--the nature-loving Mohawks are its unwilling victims.


It is only natural for the polluters to disclaim responsibility for the accumulated damage to the land, air and water, let alone the people and wildlife, because cleanup, using current technology, would mean closing the plants, removing and replacing the soil, then waiting years for natural restoration. The cost of this solution would be prohibitive. Fortunately, when man finally realizes the error of his ways and is unable to arrive at a practical and economical solution, he is forced to look to the laws of nature for answers. The solution, polarization technology, confounds the experts as it seems too simple to work. Basically, it recognizes cause rather than effect.

We represent Natural Energy Increase, Inc., and propose installation of a Starbard Weather/Water Station, designed to purify the land, air, and water for a radius of 26 miles. It is marketed on a 10-year maintenance lease, with money-back performance guarantee. The 2124sq.mi coverage would detoxify St. Regis land on both sides of the St. Lawrence River plus the populated areas of St. Lawrence and Franklin counties. Using 100,000 pop., the cost is about 23¢/acre/yr. or \$5/resident/yr.

Dr. Starbard, the discoverer, has found aluminum to be the most toxic material in common use because, it not only blocks positive radiation, but gives off negative radiation of its own. Yet we use it in cookware, packaging, cosmetics, housing, fertilizers, drinking water and transport vehicles. Is it any wonder that our food, land and water are poisoned and our health impaired? Another danger; in nearby Pennsylvania I saw how the aluminum in mobile homes acts as a target for tornados. This was nature restoring balance by DESTRUCTION. 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NATURE OF THE BUSINESS

Natural Energy Increase, Inc. is a California based corporation which manufactures and markets Starbard Natural Law Stations and other Polarity devices. These products are based on polarity technology. Both the stations and the polarity devices utilize a combination of land and sea elements that together generate natural energy far greater than the sum of the individual components. The Starbard Natural Law Stations attract positive radiation which has the ability to alter the physical and chemical components of solids, liquids and gases.

Simply stated, polarization restores natural balance to atoms which have formed a negative energy orientation. Through polarization, negative energy attractions are reversed and natural, positive balances are restored. Polarization, therefore, can eliminate poisons, neutralize harmful radiation, make toxic chemicals inert, and purify water.

HISTORY

The concept of Natural Energy Increase, Inc. originated in 1970 in Hoolehua, Molokai, Hawaii. Although Dr. Starbard-Webb had been working with polarity for many years prior to the company's development, the wide applications of the Starbard stations were not known until 1977. The ending of the drought in the Western United States, Canada and Mexico at precisely 11:41 a.m. on February 20, 1977, which Dr. Starbard-Webb attributes to the installation of a Starbard Natural Law Station, was the catalyst for the forming of the corporation. Later in 1977, Dr. Starbard-Webb set up three stations in a farming region north of Boise, Idaho. Before the stations were operational the area was largely arid and barren. By June, the hillsides were carpeted with grass and wildflowers. One local farmer reported that he saved over \$4,000 per month in irrigation costs due to the Starbard Natural Law Station.

ADDITIONAL EVENTS AND TESTS

The company reports that polarity research prior to 1977 confirms the effect of Starbard Natural Law Stations.

In 1979, France was conducting nuclear bomb testing near the Island of Muraoa. Some scientists expressed concern that radiation rain would fall over Hawaii and extend as far east as Seattle. Dr. Starbard-Webb and her associates set up a polarity station, and found that the radiation stopped at the "breakline", due to the positive cosmic rays generated by the Station.

In 1972, Kaneohe Bay in Hawaii had been a dead, muddy cesspool for 5 years. There were no fish in the bay, and algae was beginning to eat away the coral. Dr. Starbard-Webb polarized the bay, and within hours the water had turned to a clear, bright blue. Within three months commercial fishermen were operating in the bay again.

In the following year, 1973, two hurricanes threatened Hawaii. When Hurricane Diana came within 200 miles of Hilo, and Hilo was being

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evacuated, Dr. Starbard-Webb set up a Polarity Station on the Island of Oahu. Within a short time, the hurricane dissipated. Headlines the following morning said, "HURRICANE DIANA AND HURRICANE CELESTE JUST OLD WINDBAGS. THEY HAVE LOST THEIR PUNCH".

IN 1973, Dr. Starbard-Webb ran one of the most amazing tests - "Cyanide Poisoning". The results showed that:

- a. Biological testing has proved that cyanide, when polarized and fed to mice would not kill them, but they would live in total health.
- b. Even after mice had been poisoned with cyanide that had not been polarized, by immediately placing the Polarity Pillow over the dying mouse, in three minutes he would be eating more food (polarized) that was drenched with sodium cyanide, and in six minutes he was running again.

BUSINESS OF THE FUTURE

Natural Energy Increase, Inc. intends to manufacture and market Starbard Natural Law Stations worldwide. The market for their products is extensive, including chemical corporations, governments, agricultural businesses, and other companies and individuals who desire a purified environment.

UNIQUENESS

Dr. Starbard-Webb has extensively researched the effects of polarity, and is one of the few scientists familiar with the technology necessary to produce polarity stations. The polarity stations are unique to Natural Energy Increase, Inc.

PRODUCT

The product of Natural Energy Increase, Inc. is as follows:

Objective: The Starbard Natural Law Station is intended to disburse pollutants and toxins.

Description: The Starbard Natural Law Station is a manufactured product of Natural Energy Increase, Inc., designed to attract, increase and send out Cosmic Rays from end to end in all directions disbursing its full force over a twenty-six mile radius from the base of the Station. The structure is 80' in length, 50' of which is below the surface of the ground and 30' above the ground surface. The main apparatus is constructed of rugged stainless steel pipe 8" in diameter, which is filled with a formulated substance that increases the Cosmic Rays representing positive energy. This structure is positioned inside of a 10 gauge steel casing about 16" in diameter that protects the main structure from damage by the elements underground.

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The Cosmic Rays are capable of causing toxic chemicals to become inert and dangerous radiation to be neutralized. The Station is stabilized on a 20' x 20' steel reinforced slab which is protected by heavy gauge double cyclone fence with top grade security systems to keep unauthorized personnel out of the Station area. The top of the Station is further stabilized with strong guy wire to assure that the Station maintains the correct position at all times. The top of the Station is further amplified with protective shields for the necessary balance required.

Starbard Natural Law Stations offer several important benefits:

1. Pollutants and toxins in the air, soil and water are disbursed.
2. Food tastes better and keeps longer without refrigeration.
3. Harmful radiation is neutralized.
4. Plants and crops can be grown in greater abundance, without the use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides.

PROCESS

Polarity poles for the Station are created in the same fashion as the "Polarity Pillow", a small metal box containing a combination of natural elements generating tens of thousands of energy units.

The predominant element is a species of sea vegetation which has been found to be high in energy. Also included are many land plants and minerals. Poles are filled with this material and set partially underground.

When an object or target radiating negative energy is placed near a Station, the positive energy from the elements polarizes the object and diffuses the negative energy. Pollution, poisons, and major wind and water disturbances are all believed to radiate negative energy and are thus treatable with polarization.

Most things in the Northern Hemisphere have a natural polarity of attraction to the Magnetic North and to the RIGHT of it all the way down to the Equator. All manmade synthetics, chemicals, poisons, crystalline vitamins, etc., have their vibration and attraction tuned in to the LEFT of Magnetic North. COMPETITION

Presently, Natural Energy Increase, Inc. has no competition. Dr. Starbard-Webb has patented the "Polarity Pillow"; further patents are in the process for the Stations and other improvements. The formulation is not disclosed and is protected in trust. This protects the company's position in the market.

If the Starbard Natural Law Stations are utilized by the Federal Government and used in mass quantities, the profitability might induce competition. However, protection from competitors is provided by keeping the formula undisclosed and continuing research and development to stay ahead of any possible competition.

She has extensively researched polarity reversal, weather harmony and pollution control, resulting in patents on several devices.

In 1977, as a result of many years of personal study and research she applied for and was granted degrees of Doctor of Homeopathic Medicine (H.M.D.) and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) from the Anglo-American Institute of Drugless Therapy in Renfrew, Scotland.

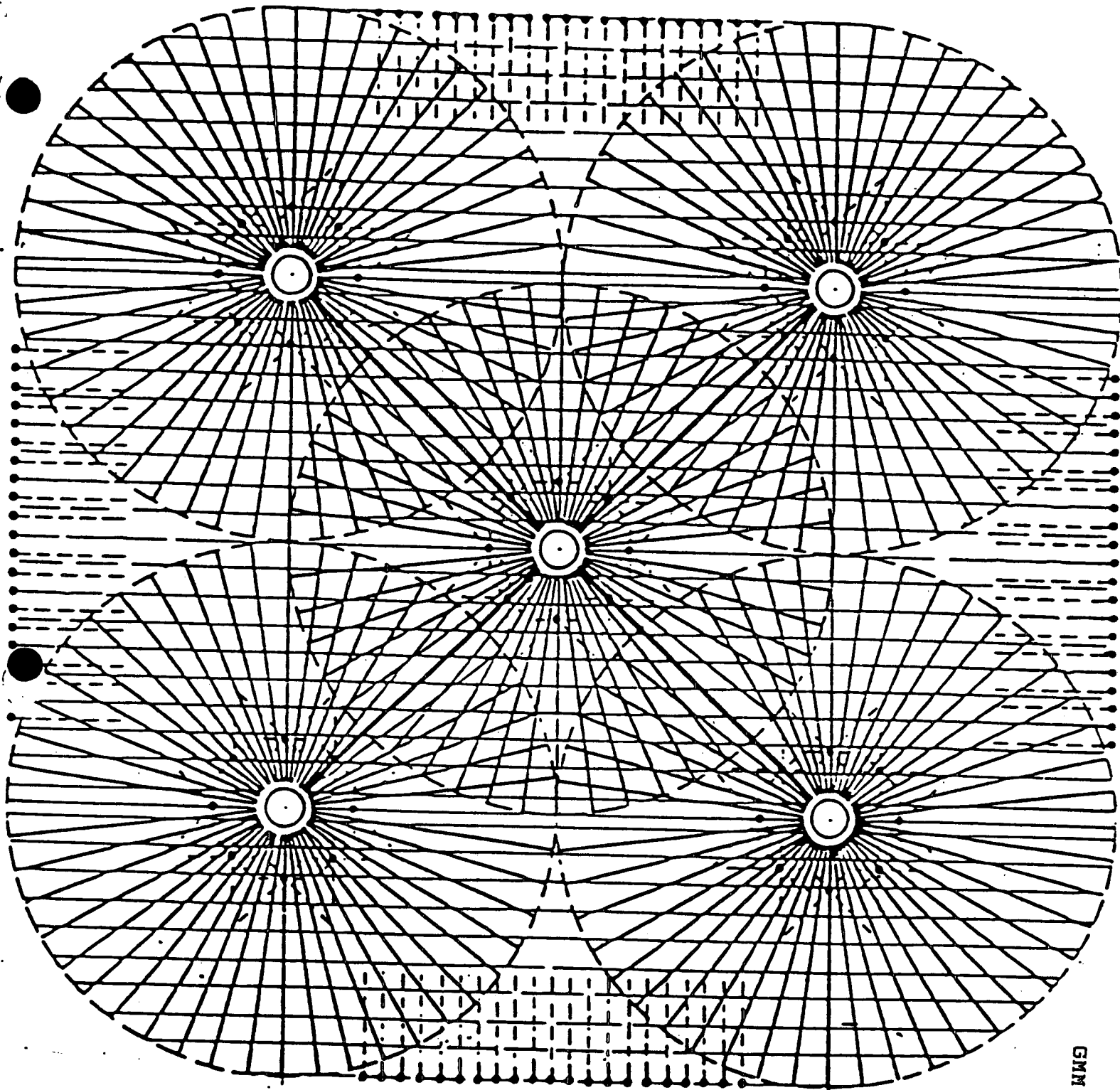

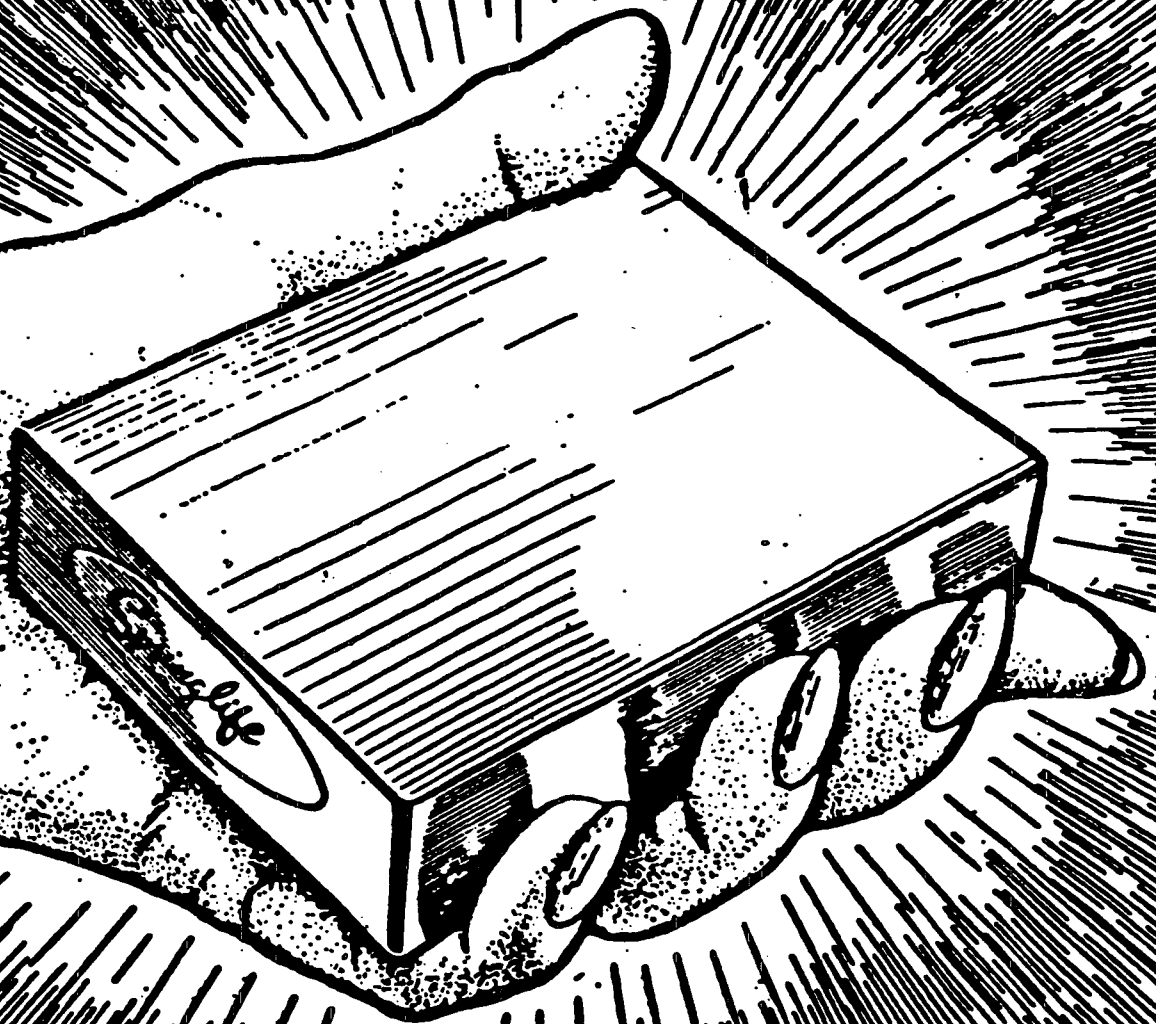
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PLAN VIEW OF (5) NATURAL ENERGY STATIONS IN "SQUARE CLUSTER"

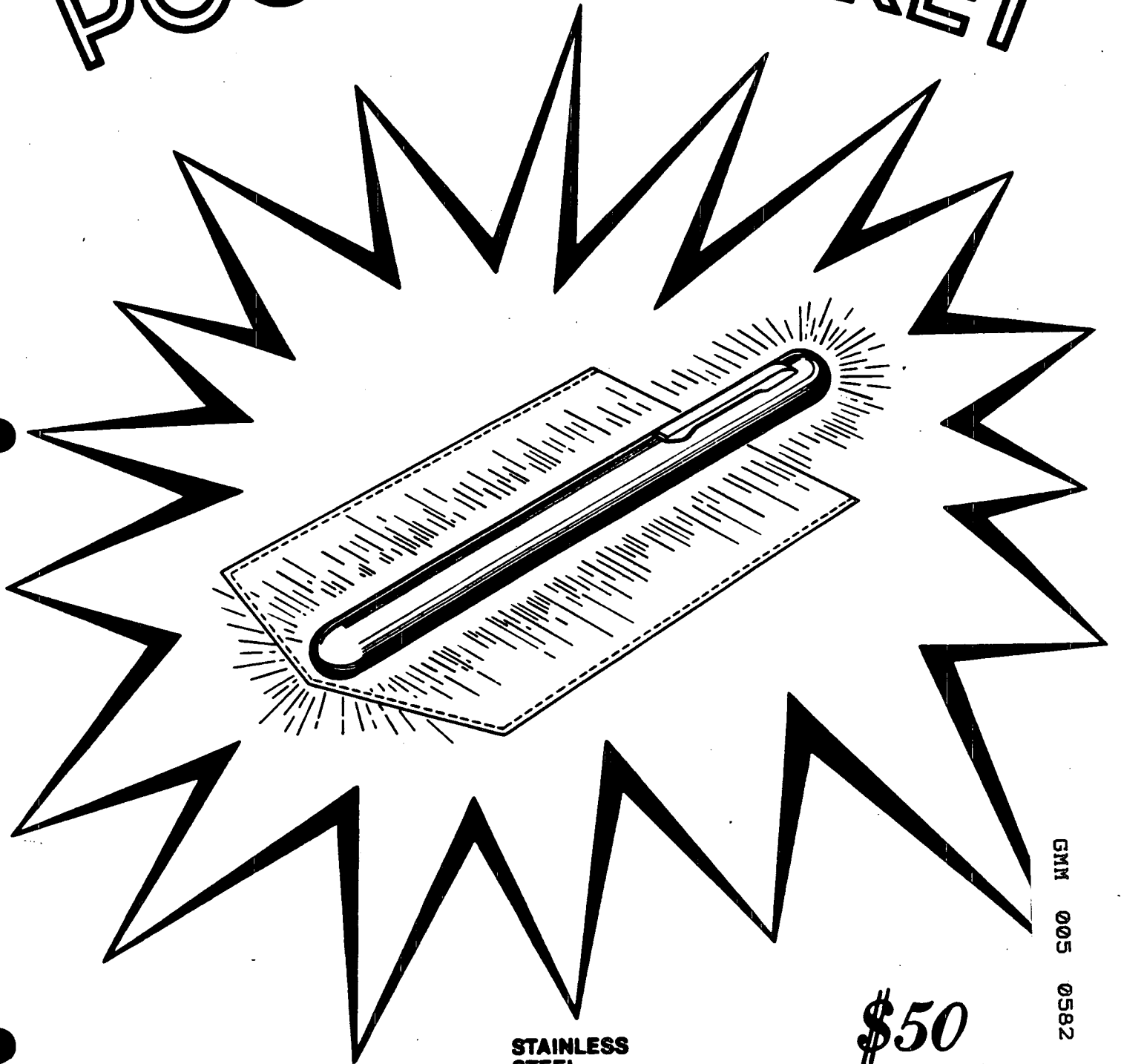

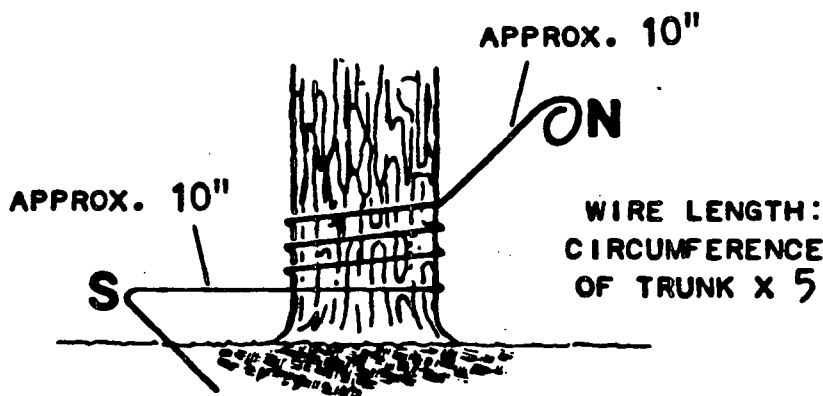
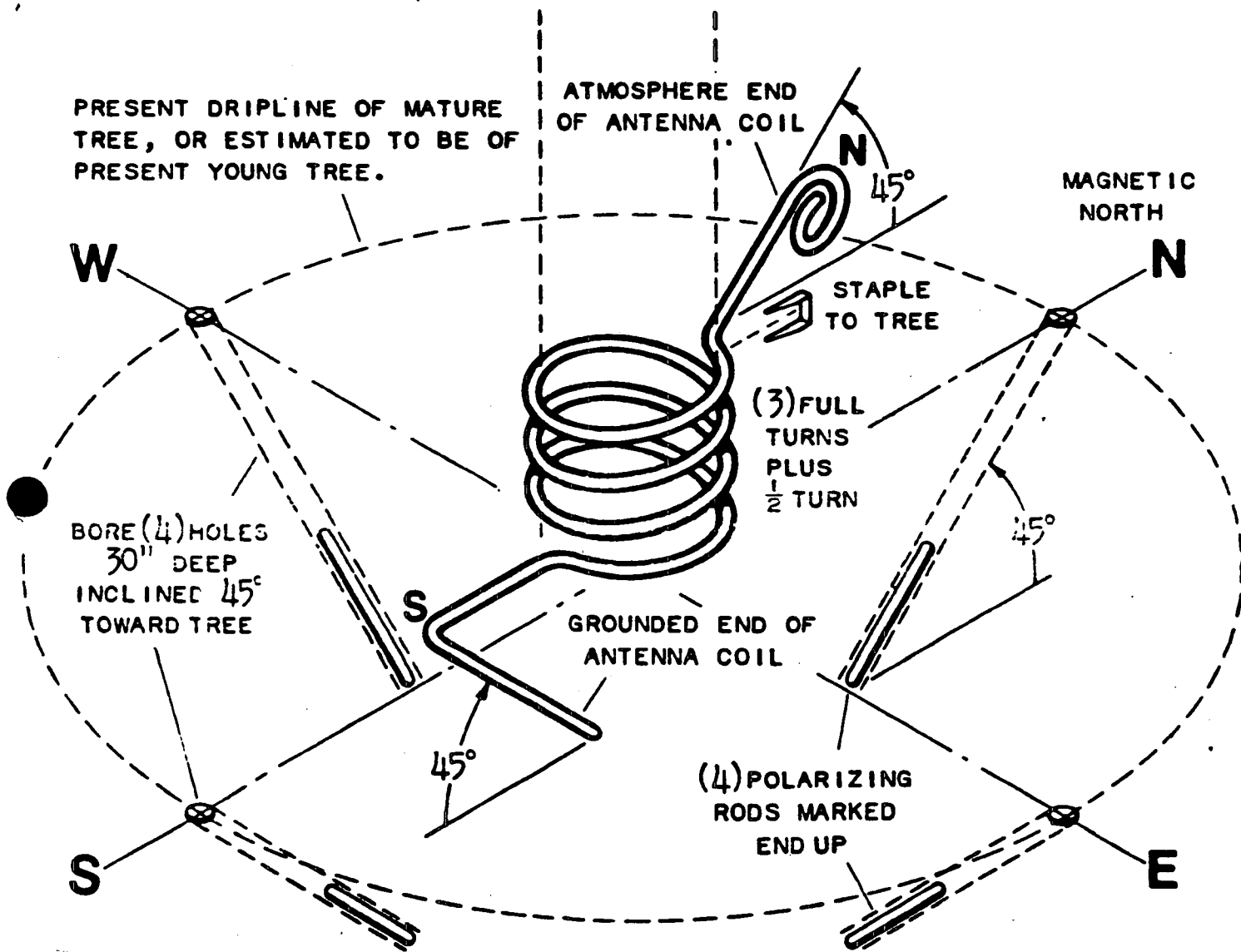
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POLARIZING A TREE

NOT TO SCALE:



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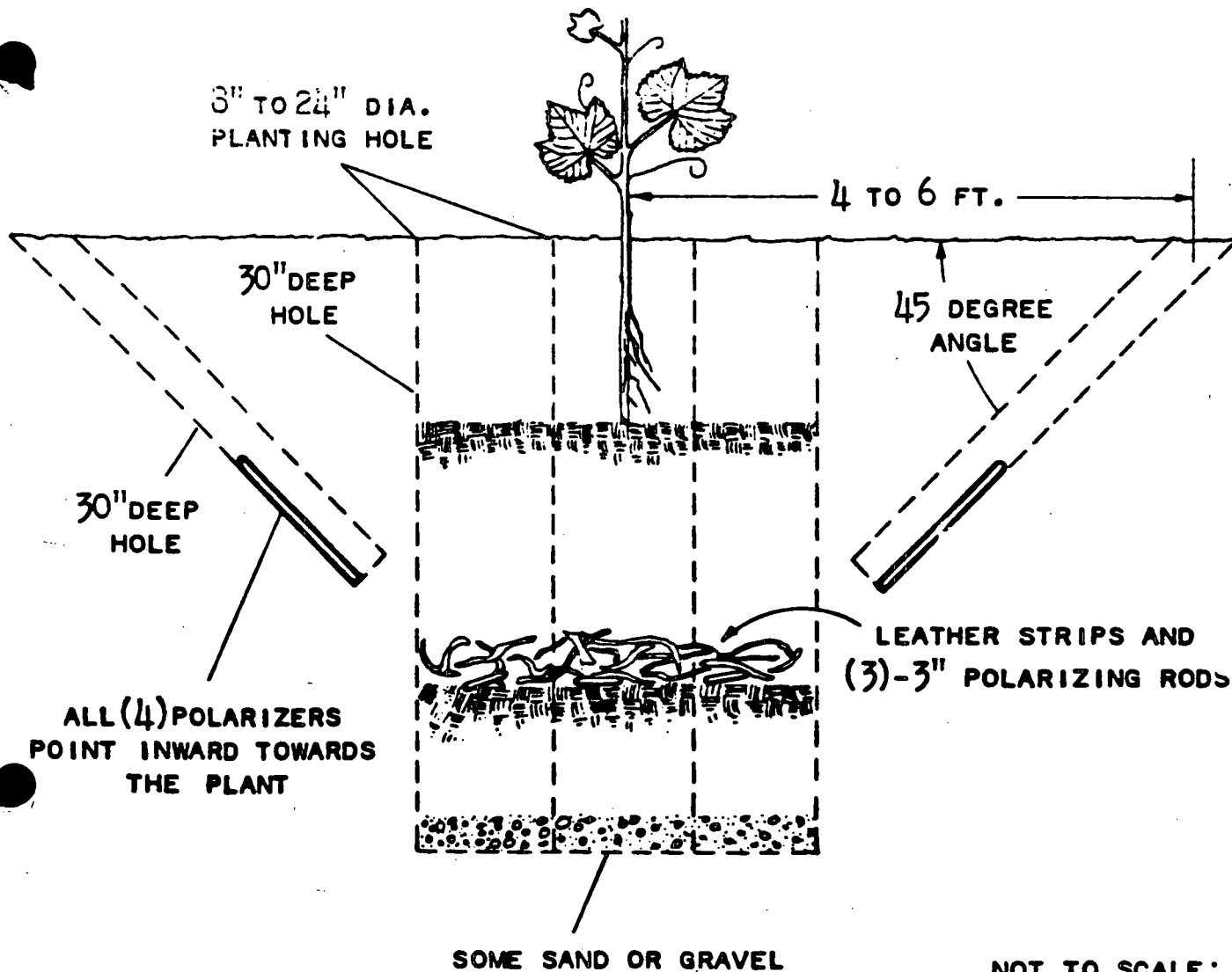
POLARIZING A NEW GRAPE PLANTING

GRAPE PLANTS HAVE THE SAME CURVICUE TENDRILS ON THE ROOTS AS ON THE VINE. THEY JUST LOVE TO HAVE SOMETHING IN THE GROUND TO TAKE HOLD OF AND PULL ON. WHEN THERE IS SOMETHING THERE TO GRASP IT MAKES FOR A STRONG ROOT SYSTEM AND PLANT ALLOWING FOR EARLIER GRAPE PRODUCTION.

WHEN THE GROUND IS SOFT WITH LOTS OF HUMUS HAVE THE PLANTING HOLE AT LEAST EIGHT (8) INCHES IN DIAMETER AND 30" DEEP. WHEN THE GROUND IS HARD HAVE THE HOLE 24" IN DIAMETER AND 30" DEEP.

AT THE BOTTOM OF THE HOLE PLACE SOME SAND OR GRAVEL, ON TOP OF WHICH PLACE SIX (6) INCHES OF SOIL. FROM A SOURCE OF LEATHER LIKE OLD SHOES, BELTS ETC., OR FROM A LEATHER PROCESSOR OR MANUFACTURER, CUT INTO STRIPS TO HAVE A BUNDLE. DROP THE LEATHER STRIPS AND THREE (3) SMALL POLARIZING RODS (3") INTO THE HOLE AND COVER WITH TWELVE (12) INCHES OF SOIL. PLANT THE GRAPE VINE CUTTING OR PLANT, BACKFILLING AND PRESSING IN THE SOIL TO GROUND LEVEL.

ON THE FOUR POINTS OF THE COMPASS, 4 TO 6 FEET FROM THE PLANT, BORE HOLES 30" DEEP AT AN ANGLE OF 45 DEGREES IN TOWARDS THE PLANT. PLACE A TWELVE (12) INCH POLARIZING ROD IN EACH HOLE WITH THE MARKED END UP, BOTTOM AND BACK-FILL.

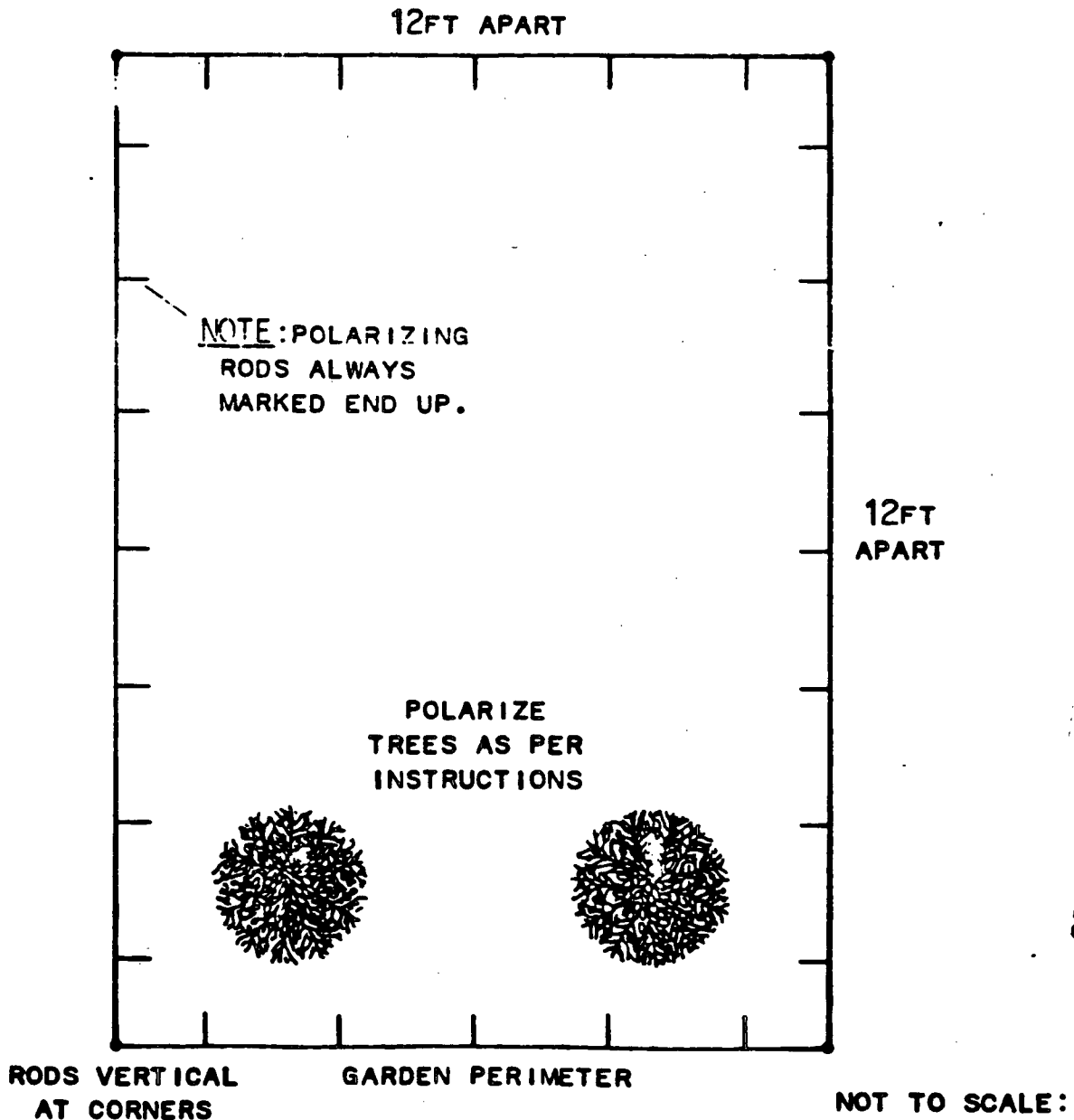

POLARIZING A GARDEN

WHEN GARDEN PLANTING IS DIVERSIFIED AND CLOSE TOGETHER AS IN THE AVERAGE GARDEN, POLARIZING RODS ARE PLACED TWELVE FEET (12) APART ON THE PERIMETER. THESE ARE PLACED IN HOLES BORED 30 INCHES DEEP AT A 45 DEGREE ANGLE TOWARDS EACH OTHER ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE. BOTTOM THE RODS AND BACKFILL. AT EACH CORNER BORE VERTICAL HOLES THE SAME DEPTH AND PLACE RODS IN THE SAME MANNER.

WHEN THERE ARE TREES WITHIN THE PERIMETER, FOLLOW THE TREE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS AND USE THE KELP ALSO. THE KELP MUST BE HARVESTED AND DRIED CORRECTLY TO BE EFFECTIVE. WHEN KELP IS NOT AVAILABLE USE OTHER ORGANIC SOIL BUILDERS. DO NOT USE MANURE OR FERTILIZERS WHICH CONTAIN MANURE.

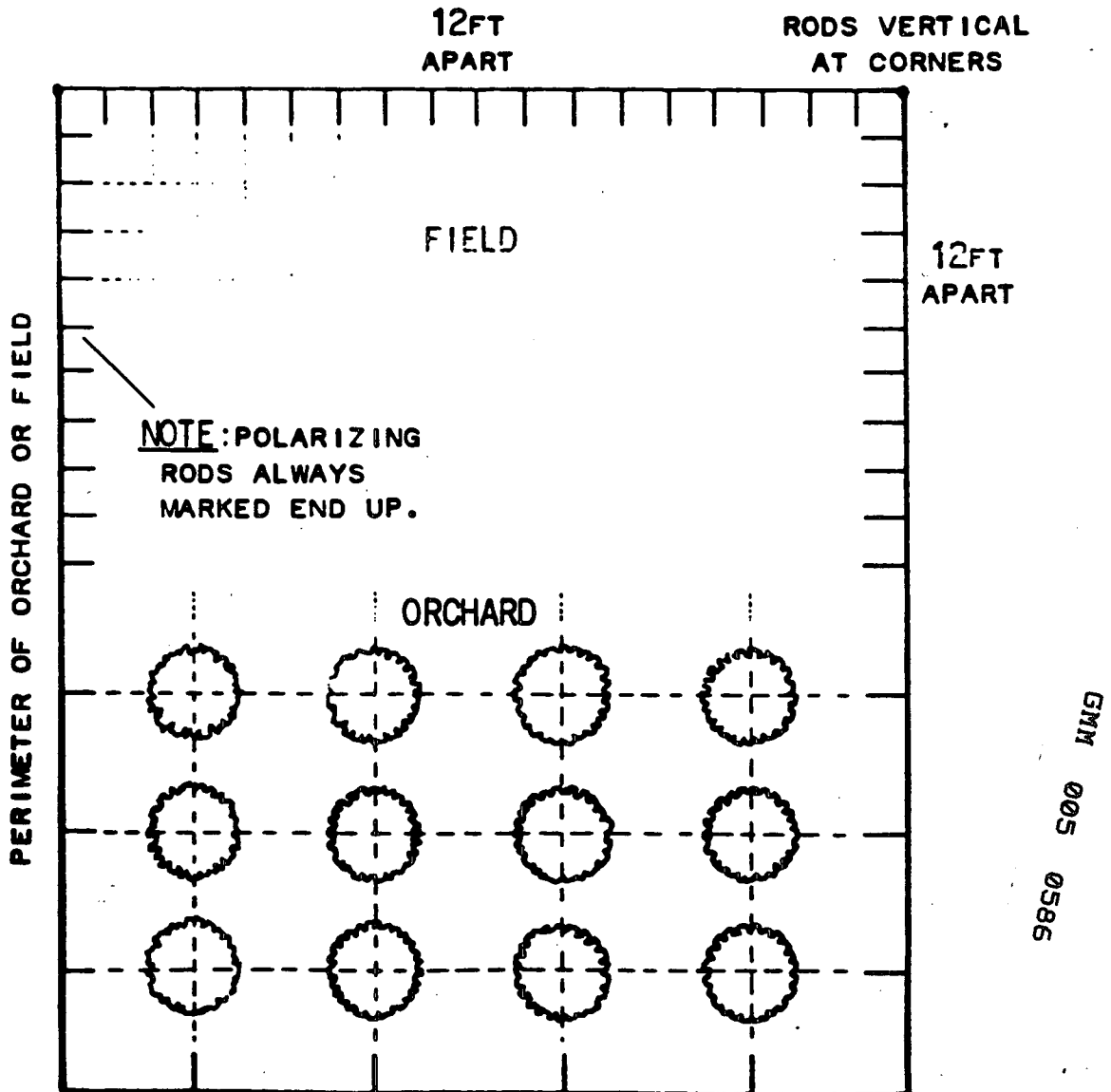

POLARIZING AN ORCHARD OR FIELD

BEFORE 1970, WE HAD TO PLANT ALL TREES IN A ROW HEADING MAGNETIC NORTH SO THEY COULD BE POLARIZED IN A ROW. NOW WITH 25,000 UNITS OF ENERGY AVAILABLE THE TREES CAN BE POLARIZED WHEN THEY ARE NOT ORIENTED TO MAGNETIC NORTH.

AROUND THE WHOLE PERIMETER OF AN ORCHARD BORE 30 INCH DEEP HOLES AT 45 DEGREES TOWARD EACH TREE. BOTTOM THE POLARIZING RODS IN THE HOLES AND BACKFILL. INSTALL THE COPPER ANTENNA COIL ON EACH TREE AS PER TREE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS.

FOR FIELDS LIKE ALFALFA ETC., PLACE POLARIZERS AROUND THE PERIMETER EVERY TWELVE FEET (12) WITH THE HOLES BORED IN TOWARDS THE FIELD AND FACING THE ONE OPPOSITE. AT THE CORNERS OF EACH FIELD OR SECTION OF, PLACE A POLARIZING ROD IN A VERTICAL HOLE 30 INCHES DEEP. BOTTOM AND BACKFILL.

POLARIZING MULTI-USE PROPERTY

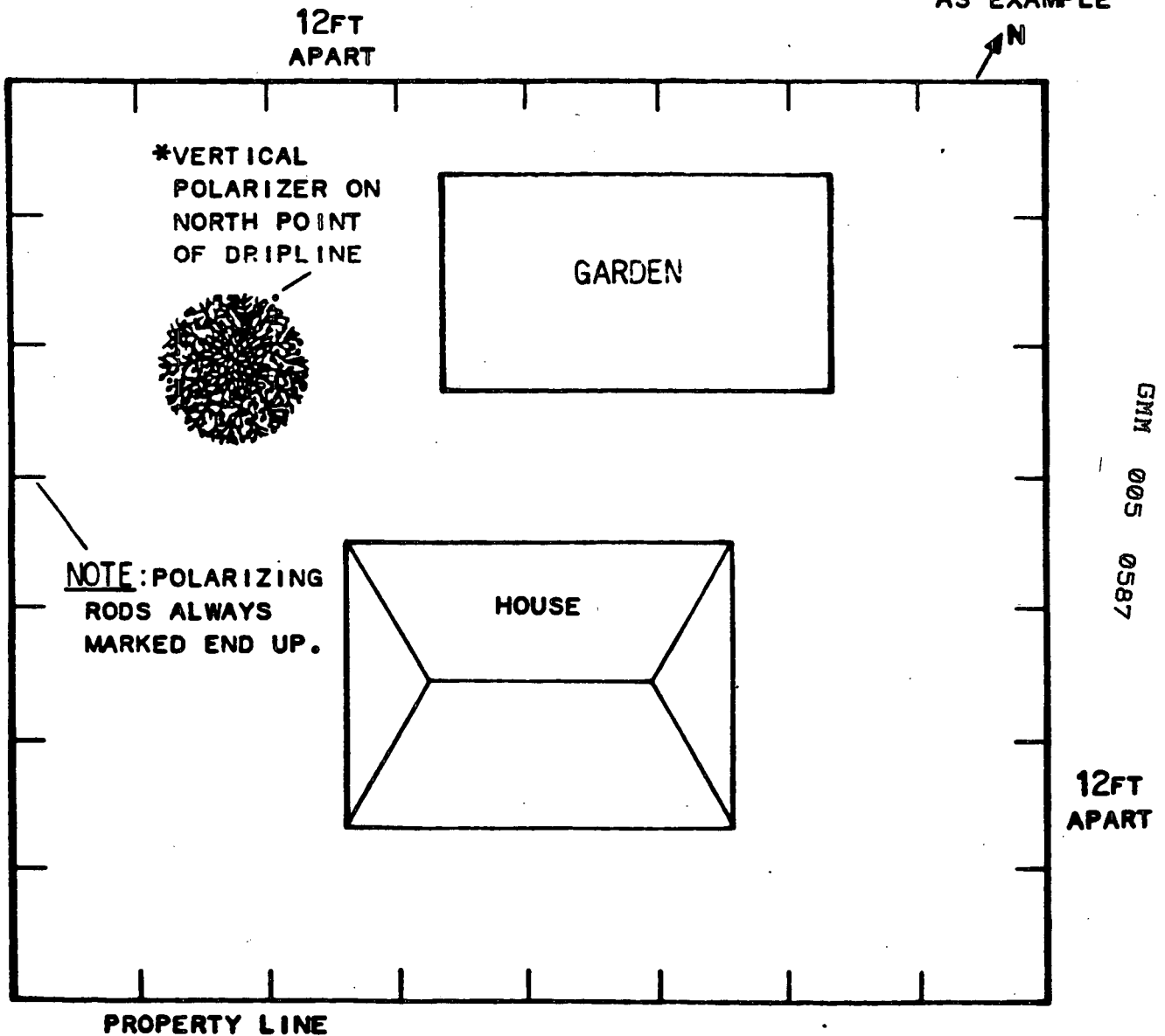
AROUND THE WHOLE PERIMETER OF THE PROPERTY BORE HOLES 30 INCHES DEEP, 45 DEGREES INWARD AND TWELVE FEET (12) APART FACING THE OPPOSITE ONE. BOTTOM A POLARIZING ROD IN EACH HOLE AND BACKFILL.

WHEN THERE IS A GARDEN WITHIN THE PERIMETER IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO POLARIZE IT ADDITIONALLY.

WHEN TREES ARE WITHIN THE PERIMETER AND NOT ON A JUNCTION OF LINES* OF FORCE FROM THE PERIMETER, IT IS ADVISABLE TO PLACE A POLARIZING ROD AT MAGNETIC NORTH POINT ON THE DRIPLINE OF THE TREE IN A VERTICAL HOLE 30 INCHES DEEP. INSTALL ANTENNA COIL AND PLACE KEMP AS PER TREE INSTRUCTIONS.

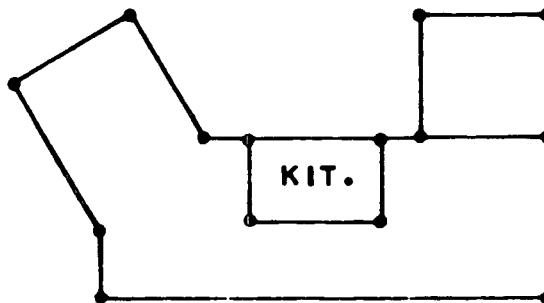
POLARIZING A HOUSE OR BUILDING

WHEN A HOUSE IS SQUARE OR RECTANGULAR IT IS SUFFICIENT TO PLACE POLARIZING RODS VERTICALLY AT THE CORNERS OF ROOMS WHICH COINCIDE WITH THE FOUR CORNERS OF THE BUILDING. ALSO PLACE RODS IN THE CORNERS OF THE KITCHEN AND FOOD STORAGE AREAS.

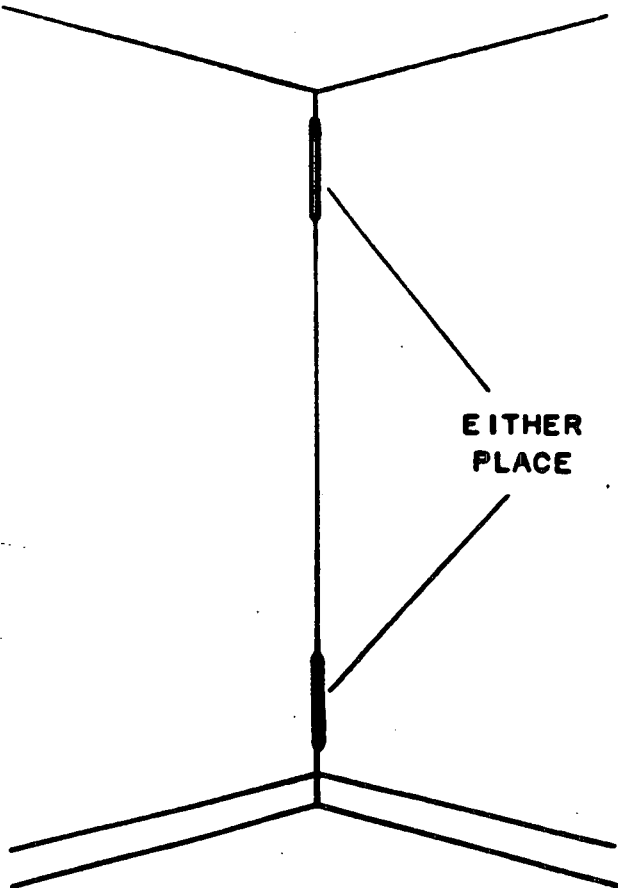
WHEN ROOMS "GO-OFF" FROM THE BASIC SQUARE OR RECTANGULAR LAYOUT, IT IS NECESSARY TO PLACE POLARIZERS IN EACH OF THE FOUR CORNERS OF THE ROOM EVEN THOUGH TWO OF THE "CORNERS" WOULD BE ON ONE OR MORE OF THE MAIN BUILDING WALLS.

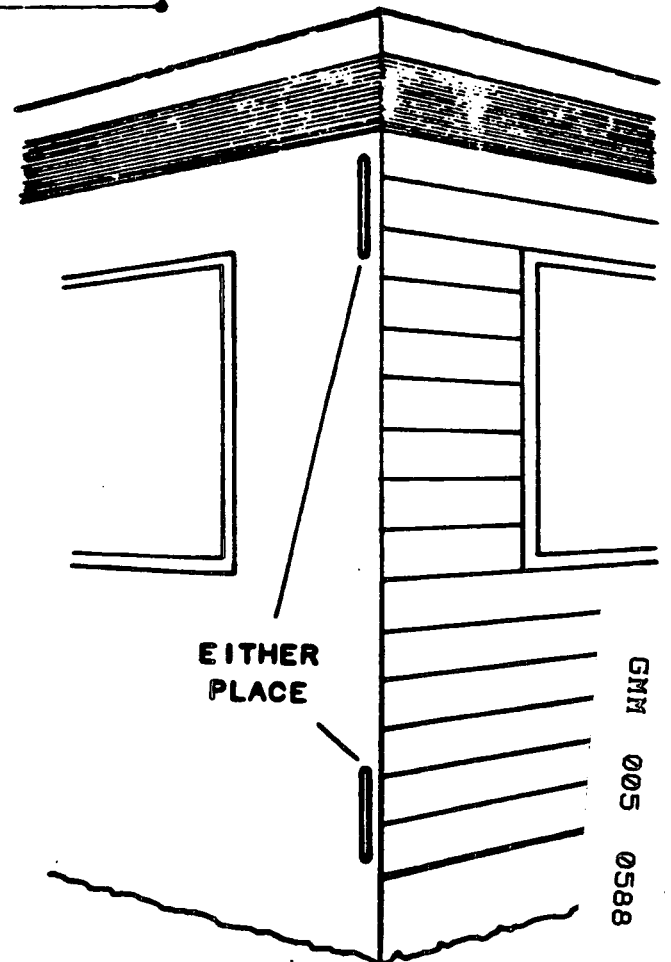

VERTICAL INSIDE AT ROOM CORNERS



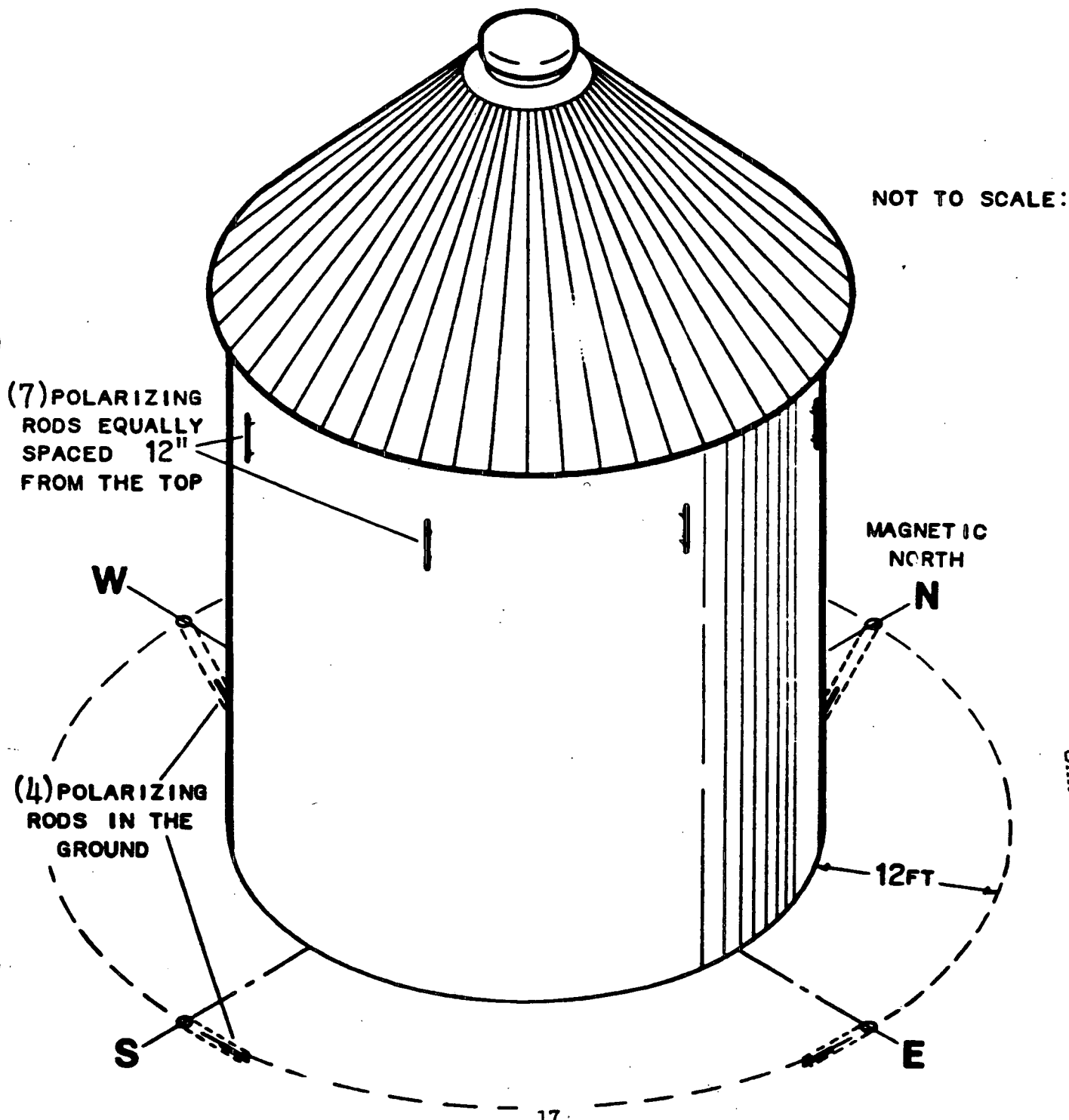
VERTICAL OUTSIDE AT CORNERS

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HOW TO POLARIZE THE GRAIN IN A SILO

APPROXIMATELY TWELVE FEET (12) OUT FROM THE GRAIN STORAGE BIN OR SILO, LOCATE THE FOUR POINTS OF THE COMPASS AND BORE (4) - 30 INCH DEEP HOLES SLANTING IN TOWARDS THE BIN OR SILO AT 45 DEGREES. PLACE A POLARIZING ROD WITH MARKED END UP IN EACH HOLE AND SEAT AT BOTTOM. BACKFILL.

AROUND THE TOP OF THE BIN OR SILO WALL MARK SEVEN EQUAL SPACES STARTING ON THE NORTH LINE. 12 INCHES FROM THE TOP OF THE WALL SECURE A POLARIZING ROD VERTICALLY WITH THE MARKED END UP AT EACH OF THE (7) MARKED POSITIONS. THE RODS SHOULD BE AT LEAST ONE (1) INCH AWAY FROM THE WALL, ESPECIALLY ON METAL WALL GRAIN BINS TO AVOID ELECTROLYSIS. WATERPROOF ATTACHING POINTS.

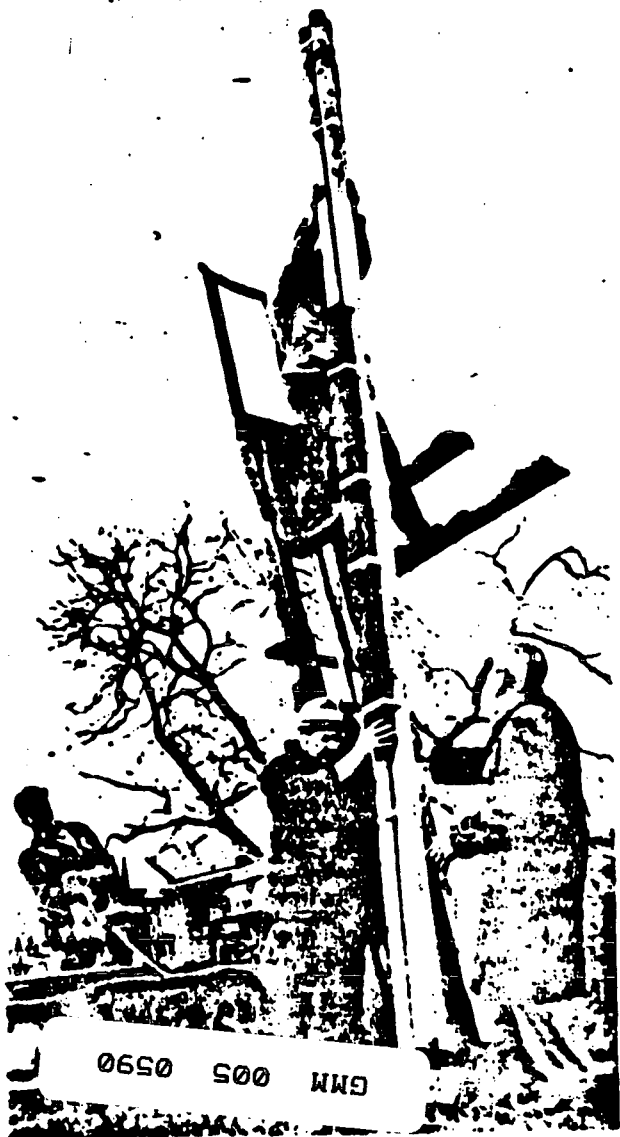

the rainmaking machine. It took part of Saturday and part of Sunday. Lawrence Lombardo used a forklift to upright the antenna-like device.

Also participating on the project Sunday, besides Ethel and Ray Starbard, Dr. Hough, Lombardo, and Robertson, was Dr. Hough's daughter, Joan Nelson of Yuba City. "She's the president of the County Employees' Association there," Dr. Hough said.

Ray Starbard, the chief engineer, told *The Reporter* that the rainmaking machine will control the weather in 20-day cycles. "For 20 days it will be working, and for 10 days it will let up," he said.

Mrs. Starbard said she doesn't know yet what day of the 20-day cycle we're in now, but "we're obviously in the 20-day cycle."

Why was land owned by Lombardo Enterprises selected as the test station? "We're friends," she told *The Reporter*. "He's really interested in this, too."

"Our main idea is to help starving people all over the world," Dr. Hough said.

Prepared Statement

In a prepared statement, the rainmakers wrote: "The scientists of the Foundation for Terraculture, using scientific and measurable means and processes, have been working upon problems of worldwide vectors which influence the quantity and quality of biological products of the world, especially those which are of use in agriculture and for the feeding and maintenance of the populations of the world.

"These studies lie in the field of terraculture, but derive from synthesis and reinterpretation of known sciences, including meteorology, astro physics, biochemistry, transformatio chemistry, biology, astronomy, geology, and geophysics."

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Starbard's 'Rainmaker'

She Turned on Her Machine, and...

Ethel Starbard knew it would rain Sunday.

When it did, she was prepared for it.

Balancing a black umbrella in one hand and single lens reflex camera in the other, she walked joyfully through a bone-dry walnut orchard in the English Hills area and focused in on a yellow antenna-like device towering above the tree tops.

The strange-looking apparatus appeared to be three thick pipes, bound together and supported by a wooden plank. It looked as foreign to the orchard as a spacecraft would look on the surface of the moon.

To Mrs. Starbard and her five associates who helped set it up, it's not foreign-looking at all. It's part of her rainmaking machine, something she's been experimenting with for 21 years. Does it work? "Of course, it works," she told The Reporter, as she pulled her umbrella and

descended into the thirty orchard.

"You did it! You did it!" one of her associates told her. "Isn't this great?" Said another: "This will change the entire science of meteorology!"

Attracts Rainfall
What is it? Mrs. Starbard said it is a hydrophilic device that attracts rainfall. It is not all above the ground. Buried some four feet beneath the antenna-like device (which is really not an antenna at all, she said) is another piece of equipment. She wouldn't say what it is, or what it looks like. Neither would she describe the above-the-ground piece of equipment.

"We have a patent pending on it," she said, "and we're not ready to reveal our secrets." The antenna-like device, though, is in the center of a 280-foot circle of land owned by Lambardo Enterprises.

Mrs. Starbard doesn't want the public to know exactly where the

test station is located; only that it is in the English Hills area.

How does the rainmaking machine work? According to Mrs. Starbard, "the method of rainmaking centers around means of discharging giant clouds of static electricity of a dry field in the atmosphere to an arid region. Certain electrolytes are hydrophilic, that is, tend to draw water, just as salt will soon make its location damp enough to start rusting."

She said she and her husband, Ray, known as the inventor of the air car, are directing experiments and collecting data "to test the validity of the present set of processes."

The rainmaking machine, she explained, is a project of the Foundation for Terraculture, a "not-for-profit scientific corporation devoted to ecological changes by non-polluting methods and with a program to increase world production of foodstuffs through both

soil improvement and weather-adjusting means."

Share the Fruits
The members of the foundation (some 4,000 persons throughout the world will be actively participating in the work, she said) "feel that all soil-containing regions of the world can be made productive and that every local community everywhere, should share in the fruits of an abundant world."

The Vacaville resident is a member of the board of regents of the foundation. Other regents are her husband, Ray; Dr. Joseph Hough of Los Angeles, a practicing physician who has a doctorate in education; Patrick Sullivan, a contractor-builder in Hawaii, and Hector Isla-Fuente of San Carlos, who is employed by Pan American World Airways.

Mrs. Starbard told The Reporter she has been working on the rainmaking machine since 1956, and this is not the first one she's built. Two are operating in the Hawaiian Islands, she said. She related she worked with a scientist in Hawaii for 10 years, from 1955 to 1975, perfecting the rainmaking machine. She moved to Vacaville from Kaneohe, Hawaii, last June.

Working in Harmony
When asked to elaborate on the rainmaking machine, Mrs. Starbard said: "We're working in harmony with the laws of nature. We are not trying to force nature to do our bidding. We are cooperating with the laws of nature and of our universe."

She said she has studied polarity and its implications since 1956. "Polarity is bringing back balance into the universe," she said. "We have a drought here, an imbalance, so we need to intensify the power in this area. Rain does not fall to the earth; it is attracted to the earth. Evidently this part of the earth wasn't attracting rain."

How far-reaching is the rainmaking machine? Dr. Hough told The Reporter that experiments have

just begun at the test station, but when the test station was set up Sunday morning, "rain began to fall at the station and in a strip extending from the coast to Marysville and Sacramento, and a total of 2.61 inches of snow fell in the mountains. Further tests will help to determine just how wide an area has been affected."

"The scientists of this experiment," he said, "doubt the effectiveness of present cloud-seeding practices, largely because they are unpredictable in results and uncontrollable."

No Response
"By studying the rainfall map of the region, it is observable that there was a noticeable precipitation in Marin County. Last week an offer was made to the officials of that drought-stricken area to bring relief to them, but there was no response from either the people or their officials."

Dr. Hough added that the scientists will "continue testing methods of discharging the giant clouds of static energy in the air, as revealed by the evening displays of sheet lightning discharging from cloud to cloud."

Meteorology, the science of dealing with the atmosphere and its phenomena, including weather and climate, is in for some dramatic changes, according to Dr. Hough. "Meteorologists are working on the wrong thing. We think this will bring the weather predictors down to the earth."

The project coordinator, Berry Robertson of Sacramento, a heavy equipment broker doing public relations work, told The Reporter that weather forecasters had predicted rain Sunday at 4 p.m. But at 11:01 a.m., right after the rainmaking machine was activated, it started raining. "I think we poked a hole up there and the rain came down," he said.

Robertson told The Reporter it took about six to eight hours to set up

science "dry" and marine science.

"Experimental cities are now engaging in these activities in various localities and these data are being correlated and studied."

So is the rain.

She said that the hydrophilic device which she has been perfecting for 21 years, was deactivated late Thursday afternoon and won't be reactivated until next Thursday. "We are planning to reactivate the system on Thursday, March 3 to further our research in the area," she said.
