

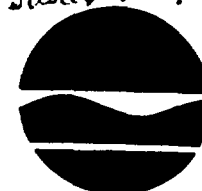

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the
Department of Environmental Con-
servation of the State of New York
hereby announces the availability of
an Order on Consent with respect to
the Coleville Landfill, Coleville,
New York for public review and
comment. The Order on Consent re-
quires that the Respondents perform
a remedial investigation/feasibility
study and thereafter develop and
implement a remedial program
which will contain and alleviate any
present or potential harm to the
public health and/or the environment
caused by hazardous wastes at the
site.

Prior to the Order's execution by
the Commissioner, it shall be subject
to a thirty-day period of public re-
view and comment. The period for
such public review and for submis-
sion of comments to the Department
of Environmental Conservation shall
run from January 20, 1987 to Feb-
ruary 19, 1987. Copies of the Or-
der on Consent will be on file and

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE
that a public information meeting
will be held on February 4, 1987 at
3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Leg-
islative Conference Room, Broome
County Office Building located at
the Government Plaza, Binghamton,
New York. The public information
meeting will provide an opportunity
for the public to pose questions to
the staff of the Department of En-
vironmental Conservation regarding
the terms of the Order. In addition,
the public information meeting will
provide an opportunity for members
of the public to make oral
statements and submit written com-
ments to the Department regarding
the terms of the Order.

On the basis of any written or oral
comments provided to the Depart-
ment, the Order will either be made
effective in its present form or mod-
ified. If the Order is modified, then
it will be effective upon the subscrip-
tion thereto by a representative of
Broome County, GAF Corporation
and the Commissioner of Environ-
mental Conservation. In the event
that Broome County and GAF do
not agree to those modifications
proposed as a result of public com-
ment, then the Order will be with-
drawn. If the Order is withdrawn,
then the Department of Environmen-
tal Conservation reserves the right to
pursue a remedy by administration
or civil action.
