SUBJECT MYERS PROPERTY

August 25, 1981

Ms. Phillis Elston, Franklin Township Committeewoman, telephoned Dennis Faherty in reference to the Myers property.

Ms. Elston informed me that Mr. Dave Schrier, (NJDEP-SWA) was contacted and relayed the names of two (2) disposal facilities:

- B.F.I. - Jim Stroin
- Advanced Environmental Technology Corp. - Phillis Leuyarder

Ms. Elston informed me that a trout fishkill occurred in the 1970 in the Cakepoulin Creek.

I informed Ms. Elston of the scheduled sampling of the Myers well water and how Mr. Myers informed me that the USEPA had performed a sampling program. Mr. Myers was confident that the well water's quality was satisfactory, and did not think additional testing was necessary.

The problem at this time is the waste materials which are being stored in the shed on the property.

The Myers want to dispose of the following materials:

- Asbestos (1 dump truck/10 cubic yards)
- White lead (less than 100 pounds)
- Sodium Flouride (estimated $\frac{1}{2}$ dump truck)

I informed Ms. Elston that I would research the NJDEP disposal requirements for these materials. Ms. Elston will call again next week for an update of this research.
