Dear Mr. Krall:

On April 21, 2020, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) reviewed and approved PPG Industries, Inc's (PPG) submittal entitled "Final Remedial Investigation Report, Riverside Industrial Park Superfund Site, April 20, 2020" (April 2020 RIR). It was brought to EPA's attention that two spills noted in Section 1.4.4 of the approved April 2020 RIR was incorrectly listed for Lot 59 but should have been attributed to Lot 57. The two spills are noted below:

- A material identified as HC Blue 2 was spilled in October 1993 as a result of a fire.
- A 1994 interior spill of anhydrous ammonia liquid occurred on March 29, 1994.

PPG submitted a corrected report entitled "Corrected Remedial Investigation Report" on June 16, 2020. Upon EPA's review of the June 2020 Corrected Remedial Investigation Report EPA determined the corrections were appropriately incorporated in the report.
