AIW Frank/Mid-County Mustang Superfund Site

West Whiteland, Chester County, PA

On June 16, 2017 the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued a Record of Decision (ROD) Amendment to modify the groundwater cleanup for Operable Unit One (OU-1) of the AIW Frank/Mid-County Mustang Superfund Site in West Whiteland, Chester County, Pennsylvania (“the Site”).

The modification changes the groundwater remedy selected in EPA’s 1995 ROD from one combining groundwater extraction, treatment and institutional controls to one that combines in-situ chemical oxidation, bioremediation, long-term monitoring, and institutional controls. Other modifications include the addition of 1,4-dioxane to the list of contaminants of concern at the Site, and the addition of Pennsylvania’s Act 2 cleanup standards, as well as EPA groundwater restoration guidance to the list of statutes, regulations, and policies that will be considered in the implementation of the remedial action for OU-1.

EPA considered public input received during the 30-day comment period in selecting this remedy. The comment period ran from June 1, 2016 to June 30, 2016. During this comment period, a public meeting was held on June 14, 2016 in West Whiteland, PA. Responses received by EPA from stakeholders during this period were considered when the Selected Remedy was chosen. These responses are addressed in the Responsiveness Summary Section of the ROD.
