SUMMARY

3/14/87
 Ms. Borello telephone and was sobbing when she reported to me two of her neighbors Liz and Harlin McGregor went to the doctor for some tests. They reportedly have 505.1 ppb of tetrachloroethene in their blood. They are very upset and angry. Further, Ms. Borello reported her son is being (or has been tested) for leukemia. In addition another neighbor, Judy Hoover, was tested and found she has toluene in her blood. (I do not know how much). Chris was sobbing, sarcastic and angry with us. She said we feel they are "hysterical housewives" and they are over reacting to the site. She feels her neighbors are "dropping" and we still do not have air and water test results.

PCE.

She wants to know if and when EPA plans to "evacuate" the area because of the impending danger. The main reason for her call was to make certain I keep Jay Plucinski and Louise Fabinski informed. She also wants to know when we will release the water and air test results. She still wants to know the depths at which we took the last well samples.

I was sympathetic and promised to convey this information. I did not offer any direction or advice at this time.

ACTION REQUIRED

What action, if any, should be taken about the McGregors and Hoover? If we do not hear from them, what action, should be taken? How can I address these concerns and telephone calls?
