Dear Ms. Borello:

Thank you for your letter of July 30, 1986, expressing your concerns about future funding at the Industrial Excess Landfill (IEL) Superfund site in Uniontown, Ohio. We addressed these concerns at the public meeting held in Uniontown on July 16, 1986. Again, we state the position of IEL on the National Priorities List does not affect funding.

As you know, we have initiated the remedial investigation (RI) at the site, and are including IEL in budget planning for funds to continue with the feasibility study (FS), the design and the remedial action. You are aware that future funding is affected by the status of reauthorization. We will continue with our studies at IEL until our budget is exhausted. We will then rely on reauthorization to complete the remaining FS and subsequent design and remedial action. We are encouraged because a new Superfund bill has been agreed to by the Congressional Conference Committee. We are hopeful that the taxing question will be resolved very soon, and Superfund will be reauthorized by Congress and the President.

Your request that we give IEL maximum consideration for funding, staffing and cleanup is understandable. Currently, there are 30 additional Superfund sites in Ohio, 217 in Region V, and 888 nationally. These all affect our ability to devote resources to any one project. As stated previously, IEL will continue to receive our utmost attention. Once the new Superfund Law is passed and funding becomes available, the cleanup activities at IEL will continue along with the other sites across the nation.

I appreciate your continued concern for the progress of our activities at this site.
