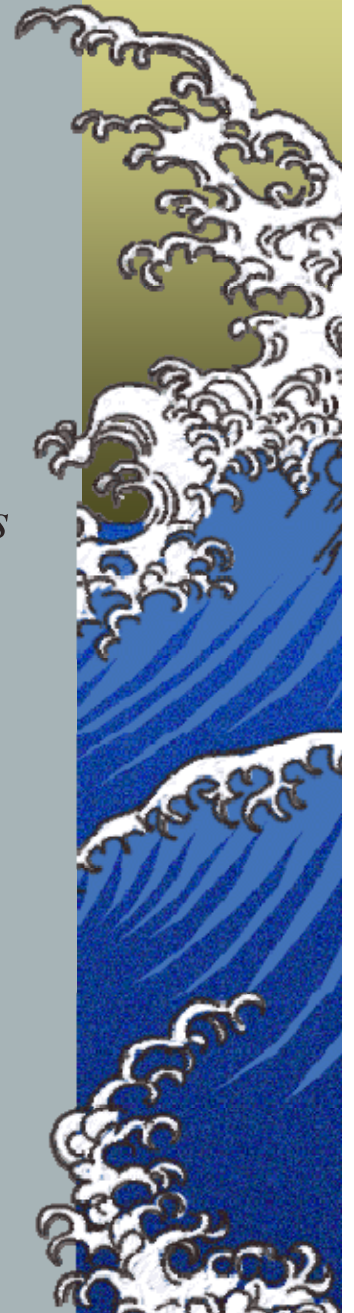

- 6. Used oil and oily water*

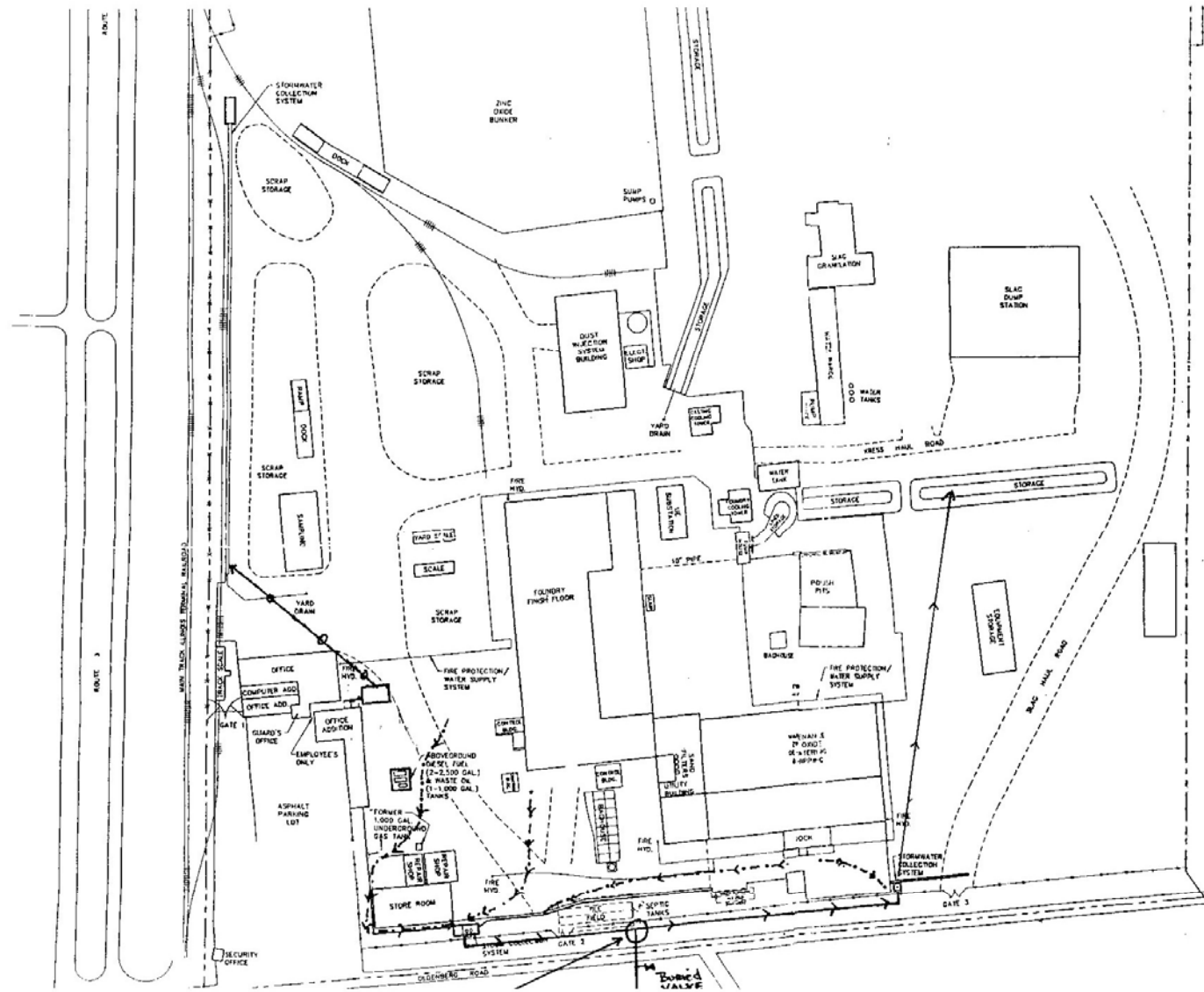


Process By-Products

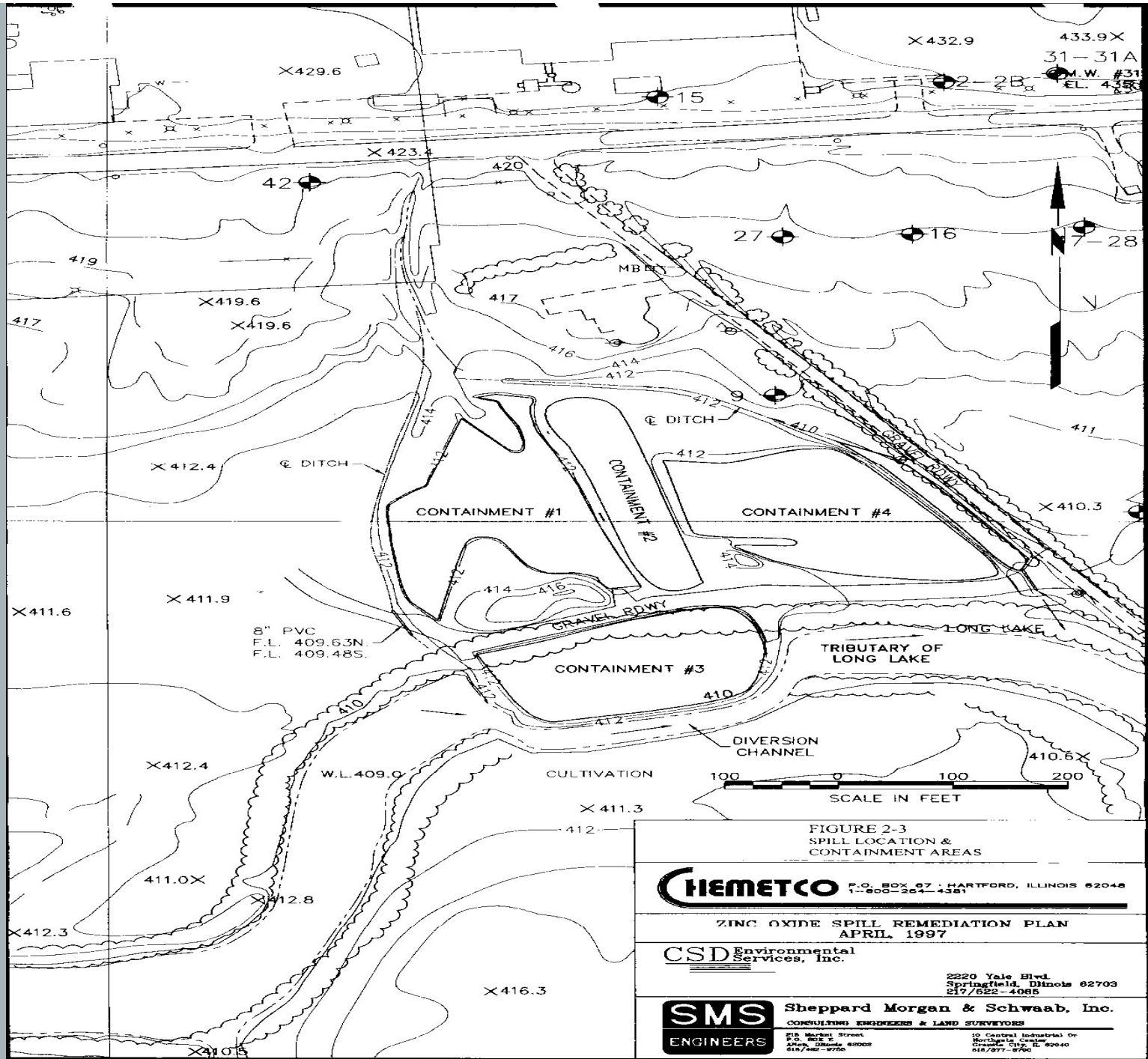


FIGURE 2-3
