Hi Mark,

Regarding our earlier discussion:

I am a Senior Environmental Manager with the Finance and Operations Section of the Office of Land Quality, Indiana Department of Environmental Management. You informed me of the need to provide an alternative drinking water supply to various residents of an area known as the Lane Street Ground Water Contamination Site located in Elkhart, Indiana. On August 29, 2007 I mailed and FAXed a Work Assignment to Environmental Field Services, Inc. requesting them to begin to provide bottled water and appropriate dispensers to the [REDACTED] residences. I will forward a "hard" copy of this Work Assignment to you.

On September 13, 2007 I received an e-mail from you listing sample results for a number of residences associated with the Lane Street site. These samples results documented the existence of TCE in the drinking water of a number of residences. Consequently, on that same day I mailed and FAXed a revised Work Assignment to Environmental Field Services, Inc. to provide bottled water to the [REDACTED] residences. I will also forward a "hard" copy of this Work Assignment to you.

On October 19, 2007 I received an e-mail from Ken Theisen, USEPA, Region V informing me that USEPA intended to install either point-of-entry or point-of-use carbon filter systems at various residences associated with the Lane Street Ground Water Contamination Site. The following residences were to receive point-of-entry carbon filter systems: [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] residences were to receive point-of-use carbon filter systems. According to telephone calls which I made to residents, all of these carbon filter systems were installed by November 15, 2007.

During the week of December 19, 2007, OLQ/IDEM staff sampled the water of the residences with the newly installed carbon filter systems. On January 16, 2008 I received an e-mail from you stating that "sample results have confirmed that the filters that have been provided to the residents on Lane Street in Elkhart are working perfectly. There are no detections of any contaminants after the first filter....You may discontinue bottle (sic) water." Consequently, on January 22, 2008 I mailed and FAXed a letter to Environmental Field Services, Inc. to discontinue the delivery of bottled water at all of the residences associated with the Lane Street Ground Water Contamination Site in Elkhart, Indiana.


