

U.S. EPA Region 6 Announces Proposed Plan and Public Comment Period Falcon Refining Superfund Site August 2, 2017



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 6 (EPA), in coordination with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) will hold a public meeting to inform residents of the proposed cleanup strategy and obtain comments on the EPA's Proposed Plan of the preferred remedy to address the groundwater contamination at the Falcon Superfund site in Aransas Pass, Texas.

EPA is issuing a Proposed Plan of "No Action" as the preferred remedial approach for the Site wide ground water at Operable Unit 1 of the Falcon Refinery Superfund Site. The "No Action" approach is warranted for the Site wide ground water due to the results of the Remedial Investigation (RI) and Alternatives Development Screening Memorandum (ADSM) which indicate that the Site wide ground water does not pose an unacceptable current risk or potential future risk to human health.
