

# **How Will EPA Test My Yard?**

**EPA needs your permission to take six simple steps:** 

All testing activities are **FREE** to homeowners!

# Is Soil in Your Yard Safe?



Soil in your yard may be contaminated with lead, cadmium, or other heavy metals from mining or smelting waste.

#### Sign Agreement



The owner signs an agreement to allow EPA to collect and test the soil in the yard.

# Soil Collection



**3** EPA collects a small amount of soil from the yard.

### **Soil Testing**



EPA tests the soil to determine the levels of lead, cadmium, or other heavy metals.

#### Soil Testing Results



**5** EPA will send a letter with the soil test results in the mail.

### **Next Steps**



6 If elevated levels are found, EPA will contact you to discuss cleanup options.
