ADDENDUM TO REPORT OF VIOLATION AND SCHEDULE FOR COMPLIANCE

On August 2, 5, 12, 26 & 31, 1994, Larry Stuck, Rick San Miguel, Chris Hendrix, Sylvia Vanderspek and Robert Krug of the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection (CEI) of Enviropur West Corporation (EWC).

As a result of the inspection and follow-up investigation, violations of the hazardous waste statutes and regulations were identified. These violations were summarized in an amended Report of Violation (ROV) dated December 20, 1994.

An additional violation and required corrective action is listed below. Failure to correct the identified violation within the schedule provided will result in DTSC citing EWC for continuing/additional violations.

I. Violation

Count 1: Title 22, Cal. Code Regs., section 66265.193 (b).

On or about August 2 & 26, 1994, EWC failed to design and maintain a secondary containment system capable of collecting releases and accumulated liquids until the collected material is removed, in that, EWC's secondary containment system was installed around some of the tanks, but not beneath.

II. Schedule for compliance

Correct the violation upon receipt of this Report.

Please submit a written certification, which contains the language in Title 22, California Code of Regulations, section

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66270.11 (d) to this office within 30 days of the date on this report, that the violation has been corrected.


The DTSC will conduct a reinspection of EWC to verify compliance.

The issuance of this Report of Violation and Schedule for Compliance does not preclude DTSC from taking administrative, civil, or criminal action as a result of the violations noted herein. Failure to correct the violations noted herein may result in the denial of your Part B permit application.

DTSC has received EWC's letter dated January 20, 1995 and acknowledges EWC's response to Count 4 of the Amended Report of Violations dated December 20, 1994. After review of EWC's response, DTSC agrees to drop this count.
