The cleanup at Midnite Mine made great progress in 2021 and a lot of work is underway for 2022. In 2021, many accomplishments were made:

- Over 1.5 million cubic yards of mine waste were disposed into one of the containment pits onsite.
- A treatment pond and a pump station were constructed to treat wastewater from the cleanup; by November 2021, 66 million gallons of water were treated.
- A contract was awarded to Knight Construction for building a new water treatment plant which will replace the existing, outdated facility.
- Of the 112 people employed for the cleanup, about half are tribal members.

What is happening in 2022

In 2022, the cleanup will focus on:

- Continuing to excavate and consolidate waste rock into Pit 4.
- Continuing to install the effluent pipe along Blue Creek Road.
- Dewatering Pit 3; removing sediments and placing drain gravel in the bottom of Pit 3.
