- Wilson Concepts operated a precision parts manufacturing facility on site from 1967 to 1987. Waste handling practices resulted in soil and groundwater contamination.
- EPA placed the site on the National Priorities List (NPL) in 1989.
- After further investigation, EPA determined that the site did not pose a risk to human health or the environment.
- EPA took the site off the NPL in 1995 after site groundwater met federal drinking water standards.
