



# Ready for Reuse

## Jacksonville Residential Property

**Site Name:** Hippias Road Landfill Superfund Site

**Size:** 12 acres

**Existing Site Infrastructure:** All major utilities are available next to the site.

**Readiness for Reuse:** The entire site is ready for reuse. Site owners are considering plans to make the site a wildlife habitat area.

**Use Restrictions:** Institutional controls prohibit soil excavation and groundwater use anywhere on site.

### SETTING:

- The site is located in a rural area. It is zoned for residential land uses.
- Several low-density residential developments are located nearby, including single-family homes, mobile homes and a neighborhood.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 977 people | 2.5 miles, 42,370 people | 4 miles, 97,599 people.

### REMEDIAL STATUS:

- Waste Control of Florida, one of the site's potentially responsible parties (PRPs), operated a 6-acre landfill at the site until 1970. The other PRP, the U.S. Navy, put waste in the landfill.
- Waste Control of Florida covered the site with soil in the 1970s and built homes. Landfill waste seeped into the ground, contaminating drinking water wells.
- As part of the cleanup, the PRPs removed homes and placed a clay cap over the site to contain landfill contaminants.

- Waste Control of Florida merged with Waste Management in the late 1980s.
- A groundwater pump-and-treat system operated on site from 1989 to 2000. Monitoring of reductions in groundwater contaminants began in 2004. Monitoring is ongoing.
- EPA took the site off the Superfund program's National Priorities List (NPL) in 2012.
- EPA completed the fifth Five-Year Review of the site's remedy in 2015. The remedy remains protective of human health and the environment.
